WHAT **JESUS** SAID
ABOUT...

8 Jesus said to him, “Get up, pick
up your pallet and walk.”

6 When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he had already been a long time in that condition, He said to him, “Do you wish to get well?”

I. The impotent man:

The word impotent means "lacking in power, strength, or vigor; helpless; suffer from a disease."

II. The Pool of Bethesda:

He was at a place where healing was expected. He was at the pool of Bethesda! The name Bethesda itself meant "house of mercy; house of grace."

III. The obstacles he encountered:

We do not know all of the obstacles and conditions which were working against this man, but two things were obvious: **FIRST**, the limited opportunities afforded him, and **SECONDLY**, the lack of support when his opportunity came.

IV. The duration of the man's suffering:

This man for 38 years, long, hard, difficult years, had been an invalid. Impotent without the strength to support himself.

V. The source of his healing:

**"IN THE NAME OF JESUS, BE
HEALED, BE DELIVERED, AND
BE SET FREE!!!"**

14 Afterward Jesus found him in the temple and said to him, “Behold, you have become well; do not sin anymore, so that nothing worse happens to you.”

17 But He answered them, “My
Father is working until now, and I
Myself am working.”

19 Therefore Jesus answered and was saying to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, unless it is something He sees the Father doing; for whatever the Father does, these things the Son also does in like manner.

20 For the Father loves the Son,
and shows Him all things that He
Himself is doing; and the Father
will show Him greater works than
these, so that you will marvel.



WHAT **JESUS** SAID
ABOUT...

21 For just as the Father raises
the dead and gives them life,
even so the Son also gives life to
whom He wishes. 22 For not
even the Father judges anyone,
but He has given all judgment to
the Son,

23 so that all will honor the Son
even as they honor the Father.
He who does not honor the Son
does not honor the Father who
sent Him.

24 “Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life.”

25 Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live. 26 For just as the Father has life in Himself, even so He gave to the Son also to have life in Himself;

27 and He gave Him authority to execute judgment, because He is the Son of Man. 28 Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs will hear His voice,

29 and will come forth; those who
did the good deeds to a
resurrection of life, those who
committed the evil deeds to a
resurrection of judgment.

30 “I can do nothing on My own initiative. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is just, because I do not seek My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me.”



WHAT **JESUS** SAID ABOUT...

31 “If I alone testify about Myself,
My testimony is not true. 32 There
is another who testifies of Me, and
I know that the testimony which
He gives about Me is true.



WHAT **JESUS** SAID
ABOUT...

33 You have sent to John, and he
has testified to the truth. 34 But
the testimony which I receive is
not from man, but I say these
things so that you may be saved.

35 He was the lamp that was
burning and was shining and you
were willing to rejoice for a while
in his light.

36 But the testimony which I have
is greater than the testimony of
John; for the works which the
Father has given Me to
accomplish—the very works that I
do—testify about Me, that the
Father has sent Me.



WHAT **JESUS** SAID
ABOUT...

37 And the Father who sent Me,
He has testified of Me. You have
neither heard His voice at any
time nor seen His form. 38 You
do not have His word abiding in
you, for you do not believe Him
whom He sent.

39 You search the Scriptures
because you think that in them
you have eternal life; it is these
that testify about Me; 40 and you
are unwilling to come to Me so
that you may have life.

41 I do not receive glory from
men; 42 but I know you, that you
do not have the love of God in
yourselves. 43 I have come in My
Father's name, and you do not
receive Me; if another comes in
his own name, you will receive
him.

44 How can you believe, when
you receive glory from one
another and you do not seek the
glory that is from the one and only
God?



WHAT **JESUS** SAID
ABOUT...

45 Do not think that I will accuse
you before the Father; the one
who accuses you is Moses, in
whom you have set your hope.
46 For if you believed Moses,
you would believe Me, for he
wrote about Me. 47 But if you do
not believe his writings, how will
you believe My words?"
