### FIRST TIME USED

• Ge 33:17 And Jacob Journeyed to Succoth, and Built him an house, and made Booths <05521> FOR his cattle: Therefore the name of the place is called Succoth.

- Is a seven day Feast with and eighth Great Day.
- · It is the seventh and last feast of the year.
- SIMCHAT TORAH
- ORIGIN OF THANKSGIVING

- BEGINS 5 DAYS AFTER YOM KIPPUR ON THE 15<sup>™</sup> DAY OF TISHREI.
- It is a drastic change from the most solemn days of the year to the most joyous. There is no mixture of joy and sorrow like Trumpets.

- THE FIRST DAY WAS TO BE A SABBATH AS WELL AS THE EIGHTH DAY.- LEV. 23:39
- It commemorates the building of the first tabernacle in the wilderness that temporarily housed the Spirit of God.

#### Leviticus 23:39 (NASB)

39 'On exactly the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the crops of the land, you shall celebrate the feast of the Lord for seven days, with a rest on the first day and a rest on the eighth day.

 THE WORD "SUKKOTH" MEANS "BOOTHS" AND REFERS TO THE TEMPORARY DWELLINGS THAT THE ISRAELITES USED TO COMMEMORATE THE LEAVING OF EGYPT AND HAVING NO PERMANENT HOMES.

 This was the seventh feast, it occurred during the seventh month, which would have been during the seventh full moon of the year and it was to be celebrated for seven days.

- EACH DAY REPRESENTS ONE THOUSAND YEARS
- THE EIGHTH GREAT DAY IS THE NEW HEAVEN AND NEW EARTH.
- 70 BULLS ARE SACRIFICED DURING THIS TIME FOR THE 70 NATIONS OF THE WORLD
- IT IS CELEBRATED AFTER THE HARVEST AND AFTER THE GRAPES HAVE BEEN PRESSED INTO WINE.

THIS IS THE "RAPTURE" AND THE WRATH OF YHVH

- IT SPEAKS OF A LIFE OF SIMPLICITY
- REMINDS US THAT GOD IS OUR SHELTER AND SUSTAINER
   OF LIFE IN DIFFICULT TIMES
- IT IS CONNECTED TO A WEDDING CEREMONY UNDER THE HUPPAH

# HUPPAH



 In Biblical times, Sukkot was considered the most important of all the holidays, referred to simply as "the Feast" (1 Kings 12:32).

#### 1 Kings 12:32 (NASB)

32 Jeroboam instituted a feast in the eighth month on the fifteenth day of the month, like the feast which is in Judah, and he went up to the altar; thus he did in Bethel, sacrificing to the calves which he had made. And he stationed in Bethel the priests of the high places which he had made.


