Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Atonement- The English word for atonement originally meant “at one-ment” or “at one with” like being in harmony with someone and in this case it means to be at one with God through the atonement that was made possible by the substitutionary death of Jesus on our behalf.

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

The Day of Atonement was a gracious day each year when all Israelites could experience a new beginning! This Day foreshadows God's plan for the final disposition of sin and the creation of a new earth where righteousness dwells.

2 Peter 3:13

13 But according to His promise we are looking for new heavens and a new earth, in which righteousness dwells.

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

The Hebrew Word for atonement is “kipur” with the verb form being “kaphar” and means “to cover, purge, make reconciliation” and “to cover with or coat with pitch.”

It's like a(Credit Card)

Genesis 3:21 (NASB)

21 The Lord God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife, and clothed them.

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Genesis 6:13-14 (NASB)

13 Then God said to Noah, “The end of all flesh has come before Me; for the earth is filled with violence because of them; and behold, I am about to destroy them with the earth. 14 Make for yourself an ark of gopher wood; you shall make the ark with rooms, and shall cover it inside and out with pitch.

Psalm 103:12

12 As far as the east is from the west,
So far has He removed our transgressions from
us.

Micah 7:19

19 He will again have compassion on us;
He will tread our iniquities under foot.
Yes, You will cast all their sins
Into the depths of the sea.

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

John 1:29

29 The next day he *saw Jesus coming to him and *said, “Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!”

On this Holiest day of the year we
have the Holiest man going into the
Holiest place to proclaim the Holiest

Importance of blood:

1. The token of the New Covenant:
Matt 26:27,28; 1 Cor 11:25

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Matthew 26:27-28

27 And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, “Drink from it, all of you; 28 for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

1 Corinthians 11:25

25 In the same way He took the cup also after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood; do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.”

2. Gives eternal life: John 6:53,54

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

John 6:53-54

53 So Jesus said to them, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in yourselves. 54 He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

3. Brings redemption: Ephesians
1:7

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Ephesians 1:7

7 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace

4. Makes atonement: Romans 3:25;
1 Jn 2:2; 4:9,10

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Romans 3:25

25 whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith.

This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;

1 John 2:2

2 and He Himself is the propitiation for our sins; and not for ours only, but also for those of the whole world.

1 John 4:9-10

9 By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. 10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

5. Justifies before God: Romans 5:9

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Romans 5:9

9 Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him.

6. Gives us forgiveness: Ephesians
2:13; Colossians 1:14; 1 Jn 1:9

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Ephesians 2:13

13 But now in Christ Jesus you who formerly were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ.

Colossians 1:14

14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

1 John 1:9

9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

7. Provides reconciliation:
Colossians 1:19,20

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Colossians 1:19-20

19 For it was the Father's good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, 20 and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him, I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven.

8. Provides cleansing: 1 Jn 1:7

1 John 1:7

7 but if we walk in the Light as He Himself is in the Light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin.

9. Enables us to be over comers:
Rev. 12:11

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Revelation 12:11

11 And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.

10. We were purchased with blood
Acts 20:28

Atonement

1 JOHN 1:1-2:2

Acts 20:28

28 Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.
