Hebrews 11:1

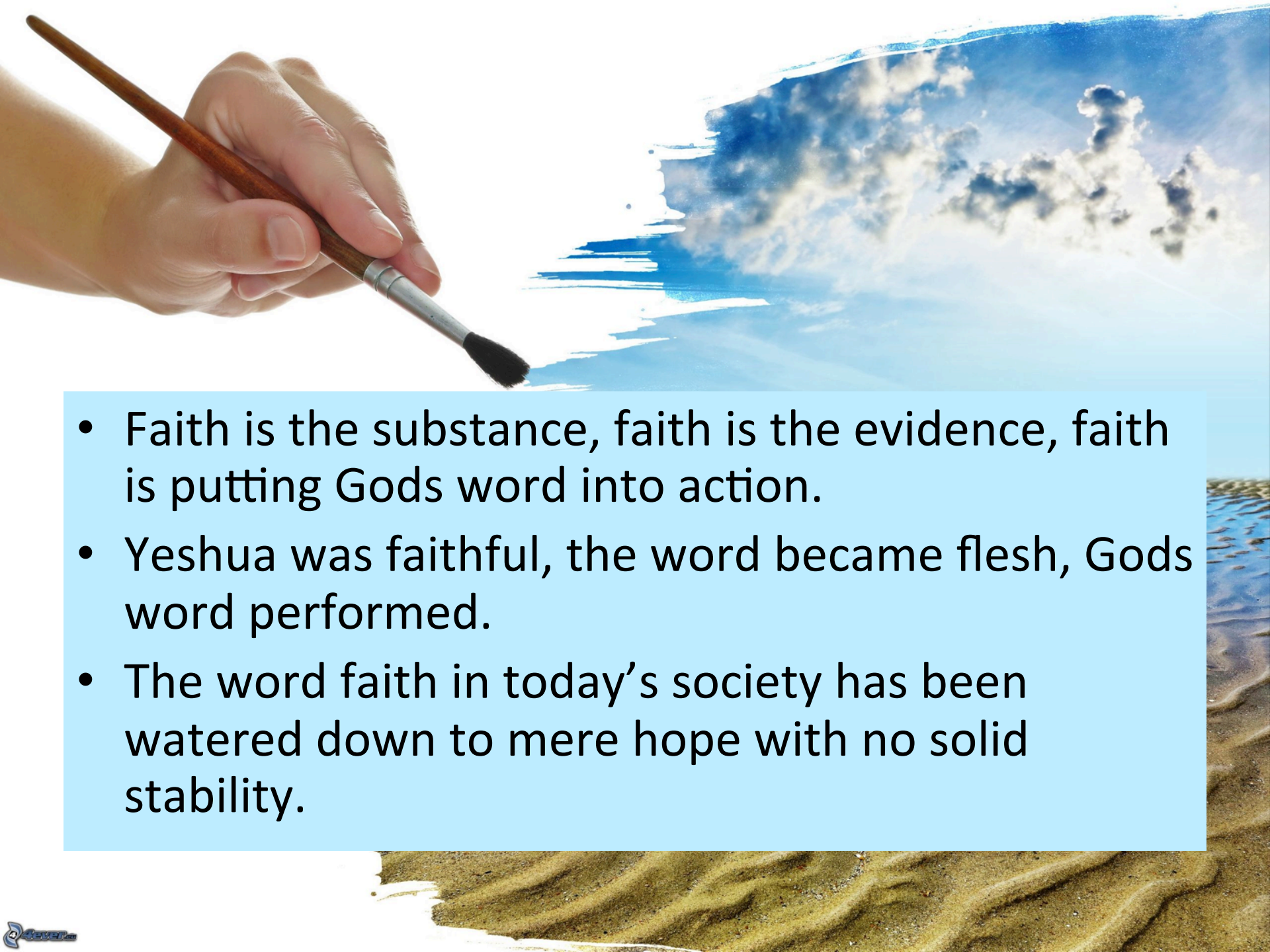

- Hypostasis-Greek
- Strong's Concordance #5287 – ὑπόστασις
“upostasi” hypostasis; gen. hypostaseos
- To place or set under. In general, that which underlies the apparent, hence, reality, essence, substance; that which is the basis of something, hence, assurance guarantee, confidence.




- Faith-Hebrew is Emunah
- The Hebrew word for faith is the Strong's word (530).
- Hebrew word "Emunah". The word "Emunah" means:
- "firmness, fidelity(loyalty, obedience), faithfulness, stability, steady, truly, verily.



- Faith is the substance, faith is the evidence, faith is putting Gods word into action.
- Yeshua was faithful, the word became flesh, Gods word performed.
- The word faith in today's society has been watered down to mere hope with no solid stability.



- Emu nah (530) comes from the Hebrew word (529)
- “aymoon” which means: "established, trustworthiness"
- "aymoon" (529) comes from the Hebrew word
- "aman" (539) which means: "to build up or support, to be firm, to trust or believe, to be, permanent, assurance, steadfast, sure, long continuance"

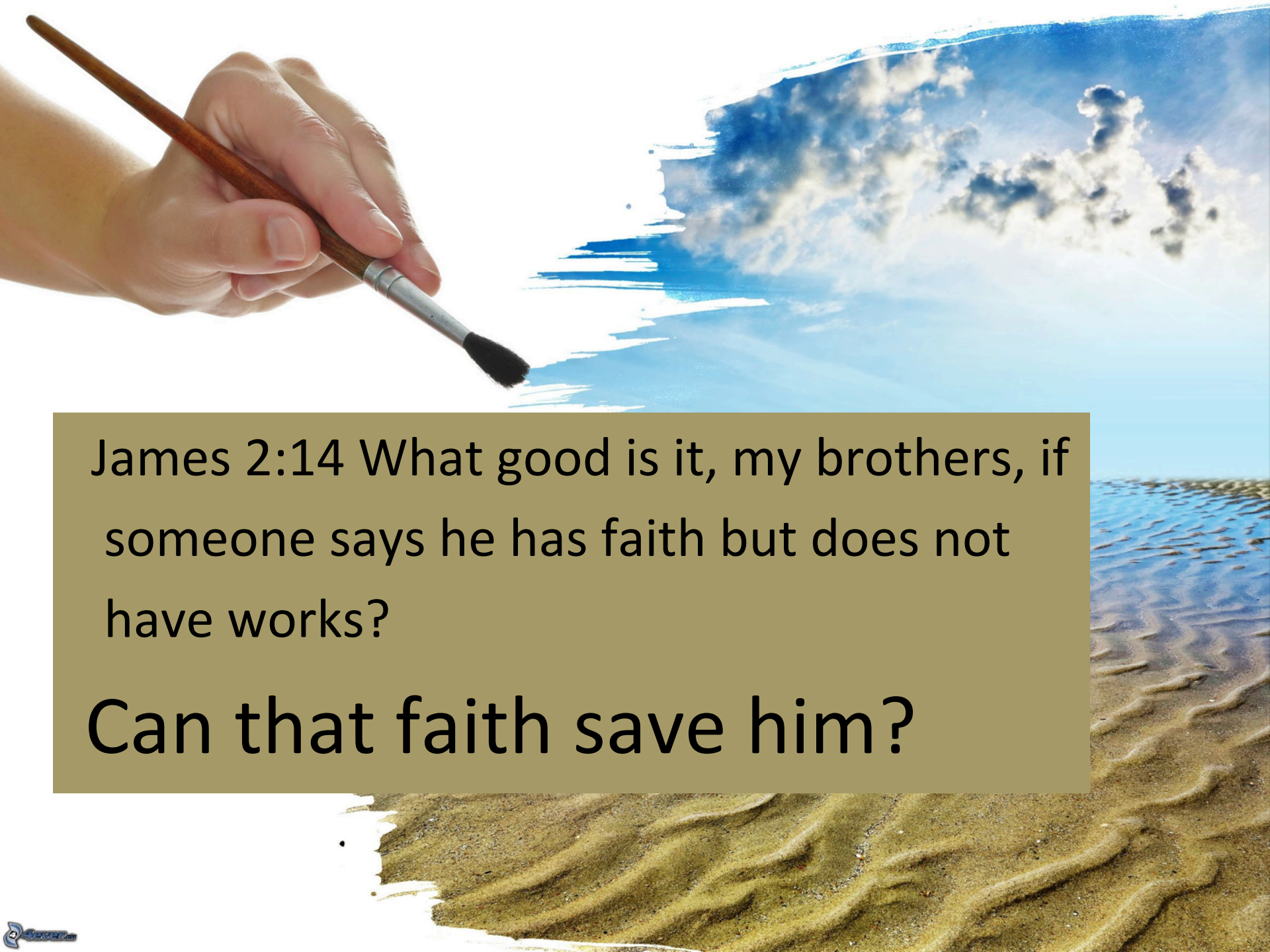
Isaiah 7:9 If your are not firm(Amon) in

- Truly, amen, so be it, TRUTH"

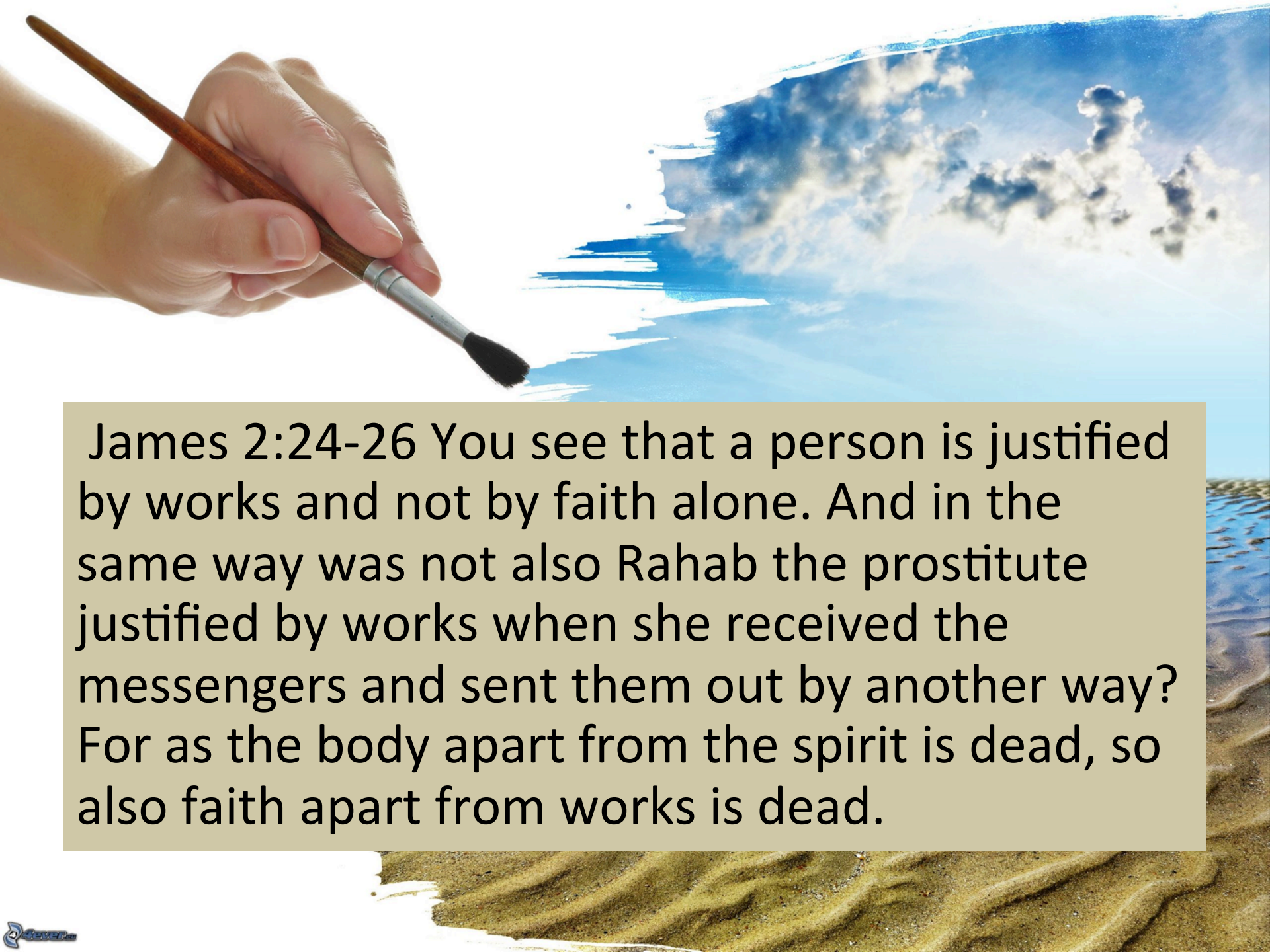


Without faith it's
