**אַנְדָּה** **noun feminine band** (Mishna **אַנְדָּה** compare NHWB).

**1** plural construct **אַנְדֹת מוֹטָה** *bands, thongs* (fastening ox-bow) metaphor of fetters of slavery [Isaiah 58:6](#).

**2** **אַנְדַת אִזוֹב** *bunch* of hyssop [Exodus 12:22](#).

**3** א' absolute *band* of men (compare **חֶבֶל**. English *band*) [2 Samuel 2:25](#).

**4** **אַנְדָתוֹ** *vault* of the heavens (as fitted together, constructed, compare Arabic **إِجَادَ**) [Amos 9:6](#).

Job 28:24 For he looketh to the ends of the earth, and seeth under the whole heaven;

Job 37:3 He directeth it under the whole heaven, and his lightning unto the ends of the earth.


Job 38:13 That it might take hold of the ends of the earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it?



Isaiah 11:12 And he shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the **four corners of the earth**.

Isaiah 43:6 I'll say to the north, 'Give them up!' and to the south, 'Don't keep them back!' Bring my sons from far away and my daughters from **the ends of the earth—**





Matthew 24:31 And he shall send his angels  
with a great sound of a trumpet, and they  
shall gather together his elect from the **four**  
**winds, from one end of heaven to the other.**



Revelation 7:1 And after these things I saw **four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth**, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

Revelation 20:8 He will go out to deceive Gog and Magog, the nations at the **four corners of the earth**, and gather them for war. They are as numerous as the sands of the seashore.
