together.

33 “There is no umpire between us,  
Who may lay his hand upon us both.

4 For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. 5 Therefore, when He comes into the world, He says,  
“Sacrifice and offering You have not desired,  
But a body You have prepared for Me;  
6 In whole burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin  
You have taken no pleasure.

What we discover, is this was the day when the Nation of Israel was to be atoned for. The High Priest would take off the royal garments and only have on white linen garments, which speaks of righteousness. Imagine having a white linen garment on and you are slaughtering sacrifices!



## Leviticus 16:3-5

3 Aaron shall enter the holy place with this: with a bull for a sin offering and a ram for a burnt offering. 4 He shall put on the holy linen tunic, and the linen undergarments shall be next to his body, and he shall be girded with the linen sash and attired with the linen turban (these are holy garments). Then he shall bathe his body in water and put them on. 5 He shall take from the congregation of the sons of Israel two male goats for a sin offering and one ram for a burnt offering.

## **In Messiahs time: Ceremony / The two goats**

The Talmud relates 4 ominous events that took place 40 years before the Temple's destruction

1. Lot for the Lord's goat would come up in the left hand
2. scarlet thread stopped turning white
3. Westernmost light on Temple Menorah wouldn't stay lit
4. The temple doors would open by themselves

## Leviticus 25:9-10

9 You shall then sound a ram's horn abroad on the tenth day of the seventh month; on the day of atonement you shall sound a horn all through your land.

10 You shall thus consecrate the fiftieth year and proclaim a release through the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a jubilee for you, and each of you shall return to his own property, and each of you shall return to his family.

## Isaiah 61:1-2

61 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me,  
Because the Lord has anointed me  
To bring good news to the afflicted;  
He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted,  
To proclaim liberty to captives  
And freedom to prisoners;  
2 To proclaim the favorable year of the Lord  
And the day of vengeance of our God;  
To comfort all who mourn,

## Luke 4:1-2

## Luke 4:14-21

14 And Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about Him spread through all the surrounding district. 15 And He began teaching in their synagogues and was praised by all.

16 And He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up; and as was His custom, He entered the synagogue on the Sabbath, and stood up to read. 17 And the book of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. And He opened the book and found the place where it was written,

“The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me,  
Because He anointed Me to preach the  
gospel to the poor.

He has sent Me to proclaim release to  
the captives,

And recovery of sight to the blind,  
To set free those who are oppressed,

20 And He closed the book, gave it back to the attendant and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him. 21 And He began to say to them, “Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing.”

## Luke 4:28-30

28 And all the people in the synagogue were filled with rage as they heard these things; 29 and they got up and drove Him out of the city, and led Him to the brow of the hill on which their city had been built, in order to throw Him down the cliff. 30 But passing through their midst, He went His way.

## Leviticus 16:12-15

12 He shall take a firepan full of coals of fire from upon the altar before the Lord and two handfuls of finely ground sweet incense, and bring it inside the veil. 13 He shall put the incense on the fire before the Lord, that the cloud of incense may cover the mercy seat that is on the ark of the testimony, otherwise he will die.

14 Moreover, he shall take some of the blood of the bull and sprinkle it with his finger on the mercy seat on the east side; also in front of the mercy seat he shall sprinkle some of the blood with his finger seven times.

15 “Then he shall slaughter the goat of the sin offering which is for the people, and bring its blood inside the veil and do with its blood as he did with the blood of the bull, and sprinkle it on the mercy seat and in front of the mercy seat.

## Revelation 6:9-10

9 When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God, and because of the testimony which they had maintained;  
10 and they cried out with a loud voice, saying, “How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?”

## Revelation 8:3-6

3 Another angel came and stood at the altar, holding a golden censer; and much incense was given to him, so that he might add it to the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar which was before the throne. 4 And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, went up before God out of the angel's hand.

## Isaiah 63:1-4

1 Who is this who comes from Edom,  
With garments of glowing colors from Bozrah,  
This One who is majestic in His apparel,  
Marching in the greatness of His strength?  
“It is I who speak in righteousness, mighty to  
save.”

2 Why is Your apparel red,  
And Your garments like the one who treads in  
the wine press?

3 “I have trodden the wine trough alone,  
And from the peoples there was no man  
with Me. I also trod them in My anger  
And trampled them in My wrath;  
And their lifeblood is sprinkled on My  
garments,  
And I stained all My raiment.

4 “For the day of vengeance was in My  
heart,  
And My year of redemption has come.



## Revelation 11:15-19

15 Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying,

“The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.” 16 And the twenty-four elders, who sit on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God,
