SPIRITE LED ACTS 2:1-21

1. The Holy Spirit is our teacher guiding us into truth.



John 14:26 (NASB)

²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

SPIRIT FILLED

John 16:13 (NASB)

¹³ But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

SPIRIT FILLED

1 Corinthians 2:10-11Bible (NASB) ¹⁰ For to us God revealed *them* through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God. ¹¹ For who among men knows the *thoughts* of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so the *thoughts* of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.

2. The Holy Spirit intercedes on our behalf.

SPIRIT FILLED

Romans 8:26-27 (NASB)

²⁶ In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for *us* with groanings too deep for words; ²⁷ and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to *the will of* God.

3. The Holy Spirit gives us joy and peace



Galatians 5:22-23 (NASB) ²² But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

4. The spirit gives us gifts for ministry



Ephesians 2:8 (NASB) ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, *it is* the gift of God;

1 Corinthians 12:4-7 (NASB)

⁴ Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit. ⁵ And there are varieties of ministries, and the same Lord. ⁶ There are varieties of effects, but the same God who works all things in all *persons*. ⁷ But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

5. The Spirit gives us boldness to witness

SPIRIT FILLED

1 Timothy 3:13 (NASB) ¹³ For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a high standing and great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.

SPIRIT FILLED

Acts 4:31 (NASB)

³¹ And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and *began* to speak the word of God with boldness.

6. The Spirit gives us power

SPIRIT FILLED

Zechariah 4:6 (NASB) 6 Then he said to me, "This is the word of the Lord to Zerubbabel saying, 'Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit,' says the Lord of hosts. Ephesians 3:16 (NASB) 16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man,

Ephesians 1:19-20 (NASB) 19 and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe. These are in accordance with the working of the strength of His might 20 which He rought about in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places,

7. The Spirit gives us the power to live godly lives

Ezekiel 36:27 (NASB) 27 I will put My Spirit within you and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you will be careful to observe My ordinances.

8. The Spirit helps us to pray

Ephesians 6:18 (NASB) 18 With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,

9. The Spirit gives us wisdom and revelation

Ephesians 1:17-18 (NASB) 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him. 18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

SPIRITFILLED

10. God the Father speaks through us by His Spirit

Matthew 10:20 (NASB)

20 For it is not you who speak, but it is the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you.

The Holy Spirit, who dwells with us, gives us power which the world does not comprehend. For many of us the potential, which dwells within us, is never realized because we will not take God at His word.
