

What is Leaven?

CHRIST OUR PASSOVER

Leaven in its biblical form is yeast, which is a living organism that creates a high state of corruption in bread.

CHRIST OUR PASSOVER

Yeast - a microscopic fungus consisting of single oval cells that reproduce by budding, and are capable of converting sugar into alcohol and carbon dioxide.

⁶ Your boasting is not good. Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump of *dough*? ⁷ Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are *in fact* unleavened. For Christ our Passover also has been sacrificed.


