# The Gospel Hope

The loss of the Kingdom of Elohim from the Christian Gospel stems from the loss of the biblical view about the future which formed so vital a part of original Christianity. For centuries churchgoers have been persuaded that the ultimate goal of their commitment to Christ is to “go to heaven” when they die. This notion is fundamentally unbiblical.



It undermines the need for the coming of the Kingdom of Elohim on earth at the return of Jesus. In the New Testament, hope (the second of the trio of Christian virtues, faith, hope and love) is directed towards the glorious Messianic future.



“Hope may be defined as desire of future good, accompanied by faith in its realization...Faith has regard equally to past, present and future, while no doubt in Scripture referring mainly to the future. Hope is directed only to the future.”

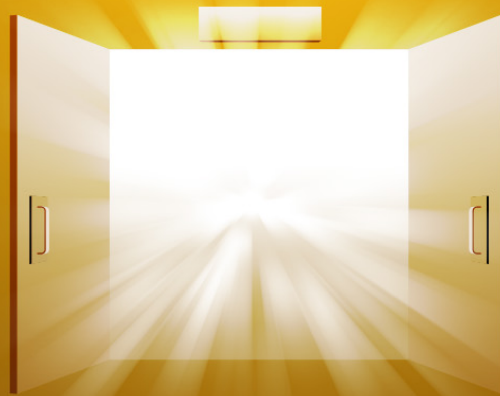


A clear hope was instilled into the mind of the believer when he heard the Gospel message about the Kingdom: (Col. 1:4-7).

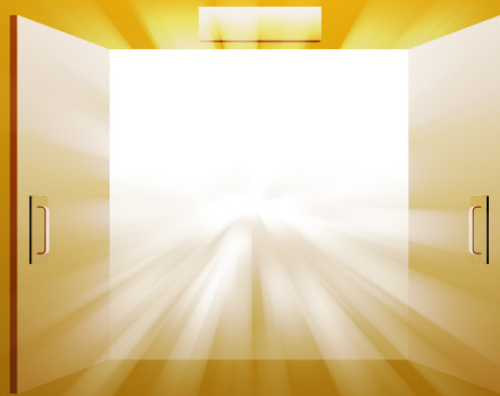


## Colossians 1:4-7

of the good news;



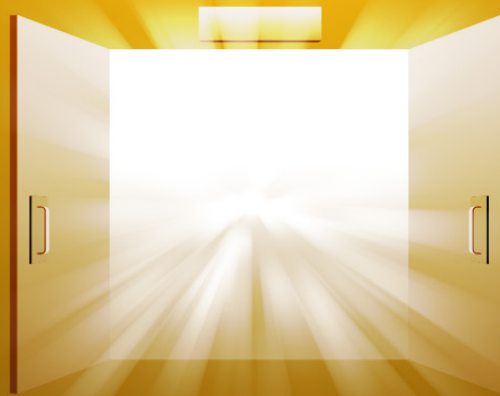
Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world;

## Ephesians 1:13-14

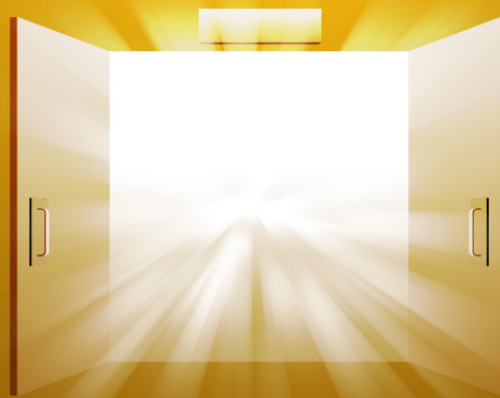

## Ephesians 1:15-18

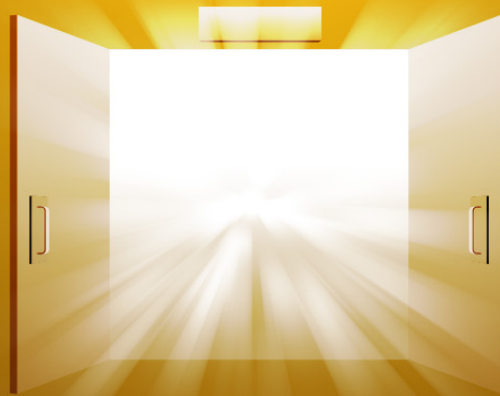
15 Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Master Yahshua, and love unto all the saints,
