# THE SEED WAR



GENESIS 3:14-15

And the Lord God said unto the serpent,  
Because thou hast done this, thou art  
cursed above all cattle, and above every  
beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt  
thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the  
days of thy life: And I will put enmity  
between thee and the woman, and  
between thy seed and her seed; it shall  
bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his  
heel. (Genesis 3:14,15)

The earth also was corrupt before God,  
and the earth was filled with violence.

And God looked upon the earth, and,  
behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had  
corrupted his way upon the earth.

A “seed war” began right there in the third chapter of Genesis. By the time we get to the sixth chapter, the battle is raging and it appears the Serpent is winning. In Genesis 6:12, we see that all of YHWH’s previously declared “good” Creation had become completely corrupted by the activity of the Fallen Ones.

This corruption came as the result of hybridization – of angels, humans, animals and even plants. We do get some detail in Genesis concerning the root cause of all of this, much more can be found in the synchronized, biblically-endorsed, extra-biblical texts.

**1 ENOCH** Tremendous detail regarding the Fallen Ones' most successful offensive campaign against the Creator, the origin of demons and the corruption that led to YHWH's judgment of the world by Flood can be found in the Book of I Enoch. This ancient text is considered by many to be one of the most important of the non-canonical, apocryphal works.

In fact, for some time, it became viewed by many as Scripture and is thus included in the canon of the Ethiopian Coptic Church's Bible to this day. Some of the Church Fathers, such as Tertullian also referred to it as Scripture:

Could it be that 1 Enoch was preserved for us, for just such a time as this? Note what the first two verses of chapter one has to say: THE WORDS OF THE BLESSING OF ENOCH, WHEREWITH HE BLESSED THE ELECT AND RIGHTEOUS, WHO WILL BE LIVING IN THE DAY OF TRIBULATION, WHEN ALL THE WICKED AND GODLESS ARE TO BE REMOVED.

And he took up his parable and said--  
Enoch a righteous man, whose eyes were  
opened by God, saw the vision of the Holy  
One in the heavens, which the angels  
showed me, and from them I heard  
everything, and from them I understood  
as I saw, but not for this generation, but  
for a remote one which is for to come.

(1 Enoch 1:1,2)

And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh:

yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown.

(Genesis 6:1-4)

1 ENOCH 6 3. And Semjâzâ, who was their leader, said unto them: ‘I fear ye will not indeed agree to do this deed, and I alone shall have to pay the penalty of a great sin.’ 4. And they all answered him and said: ‘Let us all swear an oath, and all bind ourselves by mutual imprecations not to abandon this plan but to do this thing.’ 5. Then sware they all together and bound themselves by mutual imprecations upon it.

6. And they were in all two hundred; who descended in the days of Jared on the summit of Mount Hermon, and they called it Mount Hermon, because they had sworn and bound themselves by mutual imprecations upon it. 7. And these are the names of their leaders: Sêmîazâz, their leader, Arâkîba, Râmêêl, Kôkabîêl, Tâmîêl, Râmêl, Dânêl, Êzêqêêl, Barâqîjâl, Asâêl, Armârôs, Batârêl, Anânêl, Zaqîêl, Samsâpêêl, Satarêl, Tûrêl, Jômjâêl, Sariêl. 8. These are their chiefs of tens.

1 ENOCH 7 1. And all the others together with them took unto themselves wives, and each chose for himself one, and they began to go in unto them and to defile themselves with them, and they taught them charms and enchantments, and the cutting of roots, and made them acquainted with plants. 2. And they became pregnant, and they bare great giants, whose height was three thousand ells:[1] 3. Who consumed all the acquisitions of men. And when men could no longer sustain them,

4. the giants turned against them and devoured mankind. 5. And they began to sin against birds, and beasts, and reptiles, and fish, and to devour one another's flesh, and drink the blood. 6. Then the earth laid accusation against the lawless ones.
