Passover

1⁵ Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, but on the first day you shall remove leaven from your houses; for whoever eats anything leavened from the first day until the seventh day, that person shall be cut off from Israel.





What is Leaven?

CHRIST OUR PASSOVER

Leaven in its biblical form is yeast, which is a living organism that creates a high state of corruption in bread.

CHRIST OUR PASSOVER

Yeast - a microscopic fungus consisting of single oval cells that reproduce by budding, and are capable of converting sugar into alcohol and carbon dioxide.


