UNDERSTANDING GALATIANS IN THE LIGHT OF TORAH

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of Elohim;

Psalms 14

1 The fool hath said in his heart, There is no Elohim. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good. 2 Yahweh looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek Elohim.

3 They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one. 4 Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon Yahweh.

5 There were they in great fear: for Elohim is in the generation of the righteous.6 Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because Yahweh is his refuge.

7 Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when Yahweh bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad.

Ecclesiastes 7:20 For there is not a just man upon earth, that doeth good, and sinneth not.

Psalms 130:1-3 1 Out of the depths have I cried unto thee, O Yahweh. 2 Yahweh, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications. 3 If thou, Yah, shouldest mark iniquities, O Yahweh, who shall stand?

16 In the day when Elohim shall judge the secrets of men by Yahshua Messiah according to my good news. 17 Behold, thou art called a Jew, and restest in the law, and makest thy boast of Elohim,

18 And knowest his will, and approvest the things that are more excellent, being instructed out of the law; 19 And art confident that thou thyself art a guide of the blind, a light of them which are in darkness,

20 An instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the truth in the law. 21 Thou therefore which teachest another, teachest thou not thyself? thou that preachest a man should not steal, dost thou steal?

22 Thou that sayest a man should not commit adultery, dost thou commit adultery? thou that abhorrest idols, dost thou commit sacrilege? 23 Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou Elohim?

24 For the name of Yahweh is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written. 25 For circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision.

26 Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision? 27 And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?

28 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: 29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of Elohim.
