A Study Through The Book Of GALATIANS

Romans 3:20-23

20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

21 But now the righteousness of Elohim without the law is manifested, **being witnessed by the law and the prophets;**

22 Even the righteousness of Elohim which is by faith of Yahshua Messiah unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference:

23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of Elohim;

Physical Circumcision Brought to Completion:

With the fulfillment of the Old Covenant, the requirement for circumcision of the flesh was superseded by spiritual circumcision of the heart. The apostle Paul makes this clear

Romans 2:23-29

23 Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou Elohim?

24 For the name of Yahweh is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written.

25 For circumcision verily profiteth, if thou keep the law: but if thou be a breaker of the law, thy circumcision is made uncircumcision.

26 Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision?

27 And shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge thee, who by the letter and circumcision dost transgress the law?

28 For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh:

29 But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of Elohim.

And beginning at **Moses and all the prophets**, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.

Luke 16:16

The law and the prophets
were until John: since
that time the kingdom of
Yahweh is preached, and
every man presseth into
it.

Luke 24:44

And he said unto them,
These are the words which I
spake unto you, while I was
yet with you, that all things
must be fulfilled, which were
written in **the law of Moses,**
and in the prophets, and in
the psalms, concerning me.

John 1:45

Philip findeth Nathanael,
and saith unto him, We
have found him, of whom
Moses in **the law, and the
prophets**, did write,
Yahshua of Nazareth, the
son of Joseph.

Acts 13:15

And after the reading of
the law and the prophets
the rulers of the synagogue
sent unto them, saying, Ye
men and brethren, if ye
have any word of
exhortation for the people,
say on.

Acts 24:14

But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the Elohim of my fathers, believing all things which are written in **the law and in the prophets:**

Acts 28:23

And when they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into his lodging; to whom he expounded and testified the kingdom of Yahweh, persuading them concerning Yahshua, both out of **the law of Moses, and out of the prophets**, from morning till evening.

Romans 3:21

But now the
righteousness of Elohim
without the law is
manifested, being
witnessed by **the law and
the prophets;**

20 Now a mediator is not a mediator of one, but **Yahweh is one.**

21 **Is the law then against the promises of Elohim? Certainly not:** for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law.

Galatians 3

22 But the scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Yahshua Messiah might be given to them that believe.

Galatians 3

23 But before faith came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the faith which should afterwards be revealed.

24 Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Messiah, that we might be justified by faith.

Galatians 3

25 But after that faith is
come, **we are no longer
under a schoolmaster.**

26 For ye are all the
children of Yahweh by faith
in Messiah Yahshua.

Galatians 3

Galatians 3:25

25 But after that faith is come, **we are no longer under a schoolmaster.**

Romans 6:14

14 For sin shall not have dominion over you: **for ye are not under the law,** but under grace.

15 **What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? Certainly not.**

Romans 8:1-4

1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Messiah Yahshua, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Messiah Yahshua hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, Yahweh sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
