29 And if ye be Messiah's,
then are ye Abraham's seed,
and heirs according to the
promise.

Galatians 3

and heirs — The oldest manuscripts omit “and.” Christ is “Abraham’s seed” ([Galatians 3:16](#)): ye are “one in Christ” ([Galatians 3:28](#)), and one with Christ, as having “put on Christ” ([Galatians 3:27](#)); therefore YE are “Abraham’s seed,” which is tantamount to saying (whence the “and” is omitted), ye are “heirs according to the promise” (not “by the law,” [Galatians 3:18](#));

15 Brethren, I speak after the manner of men; Though it be but a man's covenant, yet if it be confirmed, no man disannulleth, or addeth thereto.

16 Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Messiah.

Galatians 3

28 There is neither Jew nor
Greek, there is neither bond
nor free, there is neither
male nor female: for ye are
all one in Messiah Yahshua.

Galatians 3

26 For ye are all the children
of Yahweh by faith in Messiah
Yahshua.

27 For as many of you as
have been baptized into
Messiah have put on Messiah.

Galatians 3

18 For if the inheritance be of the law,
it is no more of promise: but Elohim
gave it to Abraham by promise.

19 Wherefore then serveth the law? **It
was added because of transgressions,
till the seed should come** to whom the
promise was made; and it was
ordained by angels in the hand of a
mediator.

**His spiritual seed
derive their birth from
the travail of His soul,
being born again of
His word, which is the
incorruptible seed
([John 1:12](#); [Romans
9:8](#); [1 Peter 1:23](#)).**

John 1:11

He came unto his own, and
his own received him not.

1:12

But as many as received him,
to them gave he power to
become the sons of Elohim,
even to them that believe on
his name:

Romans 9:1-8

- 1 I say the truth in Messiah, I lie not, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit,
2 That I have great heaviness and continual sorrow in my heart.
3 For I could wish that myself were accursed from Messiah **for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh:**

4 **Who are Israelites**; to whom pertaineth the adoption, and the glory, and the covenants, and the giving of the law, and the service of Elohim, and the promises;

5 **Whose are the fathers**, and of whom as concerning the flesh Messiah came, who is over all, Elohim blessed for ever. Amen.

6 Not as though the word of Elohim hath taken none effect. For they are not all Israel, which are of Israel:

7 Neither, because they are the seed of Abraham, are they all children: but, In Isaac shall thy seed be called.

8 That is, They which are the children of the flesh, these are not the children of Elohim: **but the children of the promise are counted for the seed.**

1 Peter 1-25

**1 Peter, an apostle of Yahshua
Messiah, to the strangers scattered
throughout Pontus, Galatia,
Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia,
2 Elect according to the
foreknowledge of Yahweh the
Father, through sanctification of the
Spirit, unto obedience and
sprinkling of the blood of Yahshua
Messiah: Grace unto you, and
peace, be multiplied.**

3 Blessed be the Elohim and Father
of our Master Yahshua Messiah,
which according to his abundant
mercy hath begotten us again unto
a lively hope by the resurrection of
Yahshua Messiah from the dead,
4 To an inheritance incorruptible,
and undefiled, and that fadeth not
away, reserved in heaven for you,
5 Who are kept by the power of
Elohim through faith unto salvation
ready to be revealed in the last
time.

6 Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through manifold temptations:

7 That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Yahshua Messiah:

8 Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory:

9 Receiving the end of your faith,
even the salvation of your souls.
10 Of which salvation the prophets
have enquired and searched
diligently, who prophesied of the
grace that should come unto you:
11 Searching what, or what manner
of time the Spirit of Messiah which
was in them did signify, when it
testified beforehand the sufferings
of Messiah, and the glory that
should follow.

12 Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the good news unto you with the Holy Spirit sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

13 Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Yahshua Messiah;

14 As obedient children,
not fashioning yourselves
according to the former
lusts in your ignorance:

15 But as he which hath
called you is holy, so be ye
holy in all manner of
conversation;

16 Because it is written, Be
ye holy; for I am holy.

17 And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear:

18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers;

19 But with the precious blood of Messiah, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

20 Who verily was foreordained
before the foundation of the world,
but was manifest in these last times
for you,

21 Who by him do believe in
Elohim, that raised him up from the
dead, and gave him glory; that your
faith and hope might be in Elohim.

22 Seeing ye have purified your
souls in obeying the truth through
the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the
brethren, see that ye love one
another with a pure heart fervently:

23 Being born again not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of Yahweh, which liveth and abideth for ever.

24 For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth and the flower thereof falleth away.

25 But the word of Yahweh endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the good news is preached unto you.
