Hebrews 12:18-24 18 For ye are not come unto the mount that might be touched and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest, 19 And the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which voice they that heard intreated that the word should not be spoken to them any more:

20 (For they could not endure that which was commanded And if so much as a beast touch the mountain, it shall be stoned or thrust through with a dart: 21 And so terrible was the sight that Moses said I exceedingly fear and quake:)
