Hebrews 12:18-24

18 For ye are not come unto the
mount that might be touched and that
burned with fire, nor unto blackness,
and darkness, and tempest,
19 And the sound of a trumpet, and
the voice of words; which voice they
that heard intreated that the word
should not be spoken to them any
more:

20 (For they could not endure
that which was commanded And
if so much as a beast touch the
mountain, it shall be stoned or
thrust through with a dart:
21 And so terrible was the sight
that Moses said I exceedingly
fear and quake:)

22 But ye are come unto **mount Sion**, and unto the city of the living Elohim, **the heavenly Jerusalem**, and to an innumerable company of angels,

23 To the general assembly and assembly of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to Elohim the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect.

25 For this Agar is **mount Sinai**
in Arabia, and answereth to
Jerusalem which now is, and is
in bondage with her children.

26 **But Jerusalem which is**
above is free, which is **the**
mother of us all.
