

#### Hebrews 10:1-

1 For the law having a shadow of good things to come and not the very image of the things, can never with those sacrifices which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect 2 For then would they not have ceased to be offered because that the worshippers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.



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
3 But in those sacrifices there is a remembrance again made of sins every year.

4 For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.

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5 Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but a body hast thou prepared me: 6 In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin thou hast had no pleasure



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
7 Then said I Lo I come (in the volume of the book it is written of me), to do thy will, O Elohim.

8 Above when he said Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin thou wouldest not, neither hadst pleasure therein; which are offered by the law;

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9 Then said he Lo I come to do thy will, O Elohim. He taketh away the first, that he may establish the second. Hebrews 8:13 In that he saith A new covenant, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old is ready to vanish away.



Under the new covenant Messiah Yahshua was raised from the dead, under the old covenant no animal was ever raised from the dead.

11 And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: 12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of Elohim; 13 From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.


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14 For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified 15 Whereof the Holy Spirit also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before

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16 This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith Yahweh, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; 17 And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.

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# Psalms 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.

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19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Yahshua, 20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say his flesh;

21 And having an high priest over the house of Elohim; 22 Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; he is faithful that promised 24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching
