THE FAITHFULNESS OF ELOHIM

The tempted, the anxious, the fearful, the discouraged may all find new hope and good cheer in the knowledge that our Heavenly Father is faithful. Elohim being who He is, cannot cease to be what He is, and being what He is, He cannot act out of character with Himself. He is at once faithful and immutable, so all His words and acts must be and must remain faithful.

Numbers 23:19

El ís not a man, that he should líe; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he saíd, and shall he not do ít? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make ít good?

LAMENTATIONS 3:21-26

21) This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.

22)It is of Yahweh's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.

23) They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.

24) Yahweh is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.

25) Yahweh is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.

26) It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of Yahweh.

The faithfulness of God is true and has been proven many times. We can see that God is faithful and His Word is true.

Elohím cannot líe, nor can He break an unconditional promise that He says He will fulfill. Every covenant He made is kept. Every promíse or foretelling has or will come true. Testimony after testimony of Elohim's faithfulness is certainly found throughout the Bible and is still given in testimonies by people today.

Faithfulness of Elohim - The Promíses

Elohim is so faithful that anyone who seeks Him can find Him. Faith is a gift, but even a gift must be opened to be enjoyed. As we implement our faith, we begin to realize more and more about Elohim's faithfulness to us.

1 Corinthians 1:4-9

4)I thank my Elohím always on your behalf, for the grace of Elohím which is given you by Yahshua Messiah;

5) That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge;

6) Even as the testimony of Messiah was confirmed in you:

7) So that ye come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Master Yahshua Messiah:

8) Who shall also confirm you unto the end, that ye may be blameless in the day of our Master Yahshua Messiah.

9) Elohím is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Yahshua Messiah our Master.

1 corinthians 10:13

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but Elohim is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it.

2 Thessaloníans 3:1-3

1) Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Master may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:

2) And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not faith.

3) But the Master is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil.

Our Elohim is a faithful Elohim and there is no other that can do all He can and has done.

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. Faithfulness is that in Elohim which guarantees that He will be or act inconsistent with Himself. Everything Elohim says or does must be in accord with His faithfulness. He will always true to Himself, to His works and to His creation. Elohim imitates nobody He is never forced to act out of character. Nothing can force Elohim to act other wise than faithfully to us no person, no circumstance, nothing.

1 Thessalonians 5:18-24

18) In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of Yahweh in Messiah Yahshua concerning you.

19) Quench not the Spirit.

20) Despise not prophesyings.

21) Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.

22) Abstain from all appearance of evil.

23) And the very Elohim of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Master Yahshua Messiah.

24) Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.

Psalms 89:1-8

1) I will sing of the mercies of Yahweh for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.

2) For I have said, Mercy shall be built up for ever: thy faithfulness shalt thou establish in the very heavens.

3)I have made a covenant with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant,

4) Thy seed will I establish for ever, and build up thy throne to all generations. Selah.

5) And the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O Yahweh: thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints.

6) For who in the heaven can be compared unto Yahweh? who among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto Yahweh? 7) El is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all them that are about him.

8) O Yahweh Elohim of hosts, who is a strong Yah like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee?

If I can imagine someone who can influence Elohim strongly to change His mind or compel Him to do anything that He hadn't planned to do or be anything that He isn't than I'm thinking of one greater than Elohim which is obvious nonsense. Who can be greater than the Greatest, higher than the Highest or mightier than the Mightiest?

Job 33:1-12

1) Wherefore, Job, I pray thee, hear my speeches, and hearken to all my words.

2) Behold, now I have opened my mouth, my tongue hath spoken in my mouth.

3) My words shall be of the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.

4) The Spirit of El hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.

5) If thou canst answer me, set thy words in order before me, stand up.

6) Behold, I am according to thy wish in El's stead: I also am formed out of the clay.

7) Behold, my terror shall not make thee afraid, neither shall my hand be heavy upon thee.

8) Surely thou hast spoken in mine hearing, and I have heard the voice of thy words, saying,

9) I am clean without transgression, I am innocent; neither is there iniquity in me. 10) Behold, he findeth occasions against me, he counteth me for his enemy,

II) He putteth my feet in the stocks, he marketh all my paths.

12) Behold, in this thou art not just: I will answer thee, that Eloah is greater than man.
The faithfulness of Elohim guarantees that He will never cease to be who and what He is, just as His immutability guarantees that.

Immutable- unchangeable; changeless

Elohím's Immutability

The Immutability of Elohim is an attribute that "He is unchanging in his character, will, and covenant promises.

Malachí 3:6

For I am Yahweh, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.

Hebrews 6:17-20

17) Wherein Elohim, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

18) That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for Elohim to lie we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us

19) Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

20) Whither the forerunner is for us entered even Yahshua, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

Hebrews 13:5-8

5) Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have for he hath said I WILL NEVER LEAVE THEE, NOR FORSAKE THEE.

6) So that we may boldly say YAHWEH IS MY HELPER, AND I WILL NOT FEAR WHAT MAN SHALL DO UNTO ME. 7) Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of Elohim: whose faith follow considering the end of their conversation.

8) Yahshua Messiah the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.

James 1:5-6 James 1:12-17 5) If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of Elohim, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him.

6) But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavereth is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. 12) Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried he shall receive the crown of life, which Yahweh hath promised to them that love him.

13) Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of Elohim: for Elohim cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man:

14) But every man is tempted when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.

15) Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

16) Do not err, my beloved brethren.

17) Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Elohim's Sovereignty

To say that Elohim is sovereign is to say that He is supreme over all things, that there is noone above Him, that He is absolute LORD over creation. It is to say that His Lordship over creation means that there is nothing out of His control, nothing that Elohim hasn't foreseen and planned. The sovereignty of Elohim represents the ability to exercise His <u>holy will</u> or <u>supremacy</u>. The Most High, LORD of Heaven and Earth has the unlimited power to do what He has resolved.

Isaiah 46:9-10

9) Remember the former things of old: for I am El, and there is none else; I am Elohim, and there is none like me,

10) Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

Deuteronomy 4:39-40

39) Know therefore this day, and consider it in thine heart, that Yahweh he is Elohim in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: there is none else.

40) Thou shalt keep therefore his statutes, and his commandments, which I command thee this day, that it may go well with thee, and with thy children after thee, and that thou mayest prolong thy days upon the earth, which Yahweh thy Elohim giveth thee, for ever.

Job 12:9-10, 16-25

9) Who knoweth not in all these that the hand of Yahweh hath wrought this?

10In whose hand is the soul of every living thing, and the breath of all mankind.

16) With him is strength and wisdom: the deceived and the deceiver are his.

17) He leadeth counsellors away spoiled, and maketh the judges fools.

18) He looseth the bond of kings, and girdeth their loins with a girdle.

19) He leadeth princes away spoiled, and overthroweth the mighty.

20) He removeth away the speech of the trusty, and taketh away the understanding of the aged.

21) He poureth contempt upon princes, and weakeneth the strength of the mighty.

22) He discovereth deep things out of darkness, and bringeth out to light the shadow of death.

23)He increaseth the nations, and destroyeth them: he enlargeth the nations, and straiteneth them again. 24) He taketh away the heart of the chief of the people of the earth, and causeth them to wander in a wilderness where there is no way.

25) They grope in the dark without light, and he maketh them to stagger like a drunken man.

Jeremiah 18:1-6

1) The word which came to Jeremiah from Yahweh, saying,

2) Arise, and go down to the potter's house, and there I will cause thee to hear my words.

3) Then I went down to the potter's house, and, behold, he wrought a work on the wheels.

4) And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it.

5) Then the word of Yahweh came to me, saying,

6) O house of Israel, cannot I do with you as this potter? saith Yahweh. Behold, as the clay is in the potter's hand, so are ye in mine hand, O house of Israel. Divine sovereignty signifies that Elohim is the One who sits on the Throne of the universe. He is Elohim in name as well as in all things, directing all things, and "who works out everything with the purpose of his will"

Isaíah 40:22

It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in:

Colossíans 1:16-17

16) For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

17) And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

Ephesians 1:11

In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own <u>will</u>:

Proverbs 21:1

The king's heart is in the hand of Yahweh, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will. There is absolutely nothing that happens in the Universe that is outside of Elohim's influence and authority. Sovereignty of Elohim, His absolute right to do all things according to His pleasure.
