1 And certain men which
came down from Judaea
taught the brethren, and
said, Except ye be
circumcised after the manner
of Moses, ye cannot be
saved.

Deuteronomy 17: 8-9

If there arise a matter too hard for thee in judgment, between blood and blood, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, being matters of controversy within thy gates: then shalt thou arise, and get thee up into the place which Yahweh thy Elohim shall choose;

15 He saith unto them, But
whom say ye that I am?

16 And Simon Peter answered
and said, **Thou art the Messiah,
the Son of the living Elohim.**

20 Then charged he his disciples that they should tell no man that he was Yahshua the Messiah.

Matthew 19:27-28

27 Then answered Peter and said unto him, Behold, we have forsaken all, and followed thee; what shall we have therefore?

28 And Yahshua said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, **ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.**

Acts 15:3-5

3 And being brought on their way by the assembly, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great joy unto all the brethren.

Genesis 17:1-14

1 And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, Yahweh appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty El; walk before me, and be thou perfect.

2 And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly.

3 And Abram fell on his face:
and Elohim talked with him,
saying,

4 As for me, behold, my
covenant is with thee, and thou
shalt be a father of many
nations.

5 Neither shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee.

6 And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee.

7 And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, to be an Elohim unto thee, and to thy seed after thee.

8 And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; and I will be their Elohim.

9 And Elohim said unto Abraham, Thou shalt keep my covenant therefore, thou, and thy seed after thee in their generations.

10 This is my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised.

11 And ye shall circumcise the
flesh of your foreskin; **and it shall
be a token of the covenant
betwixt me and you.**

12 And he that is eight days old
shall be circumcised among you,
every man child in your
generations, **he that is born in the
house, or bought with money of
any stranger, which is not of thy
seed.**

13 He that is born in thy house,
and he that is bought with thy
money, **must needs be
circumcised:** and my covenant
shall be in your flesh for an
everlasting covenant.

14 And the uncircumcised man
child whose flesh of his foreskin is
not circumcised, **that soul shall be
cut off from his people; he hath
broken my covenant.**

Colossians 2:8-11

8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Messiah.

9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Majesty in person bodily.

10 And ye are complete in him,
which is the head of all
principality and power:

11 In whom also ye are
circumcised with the
circumcision made without
hands, in putting off the body of
the sins of the flesh by the

Romans 4:1-16

1 What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, hath found?

2 For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to glory; but not before Elohim.

3 For what saith the scripture?
Abraham believed Elohim, and it
was counted unto him for
righteousness.

4 Now to him that worketh is
the reward not reckoned of
grace, but of debt.

5 But to him that worketh not,
but believeth on him that
justifieth the wicked, his faith is
counted for righteousness.

6 Even as David also describeth
the blessedness of the man,
unto whom Elohim imputeth
righteousness without works,

7 Saying, Blessed are they
whose iniquities are forgiven,
and whose sins are covered.

8 Blessed is the man to whom
Yahweh will not impute sin.

9 Cometh this blessedness then upon the circumcision only, or upon the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness.

10 How was it then reckoned? when he was in circumcision, or in uncircumcision? **Not in circumcision, but in uncircumcision.**

11 And he received the sign of
circumcision, **a seal of the
righteousness of the faith** which
he had yet being uncircumcised:
that he might be the father of
all them that believe, though
they be not circumcised; that
righteousness might be imputed
unto them also:

Ephesians 1:9-14

9 Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself:

10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Messiah, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:

11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Messiah.

13 In whom ye also trusted,
after that ye heard the word of
truth, the good news of your
salvation: in whom also after
that ye believed, ye were **sealed**
with that Holy Spirit of promise,
14 Which is the **earnest** of our
inheritance until the redemption
of the purchased possession,
unto the praise of his glory.

Isaiah 8:13-16

13 Sanctify Yahweh of hosts himself; and **let him be your fear**, and let him be your dread.

14 And he shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

15 And many among them shall

16 Bind up the testimony, **seal**
the law among my disciples.

Jeremiah 31:31-34

31 Behold, the days come, saith Yahweh, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them, saith Yahweh:

33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith Yahweh, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their Elohim, and they shall be my people.

34 And they shall teach no more
every man his neighbour, and
every man his brother, saying,
Know Yahweh: for they shall all
know me, from the least of
them unto the greatest of them,
saith Yahweh: for I will forgive

1 John 3:1-11

1 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of Yahweh: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

2 Beloved, now are we the sons of Yahweh, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

4 Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law.

manifested to take away our
sins; and in him is no sin.

6 Whosoever abideth in him
sinneth not: whosoever sinneth
hath not seen him, neither
known him.

7 Little children, let no man deceive you: he that doeth righteousness is righteous, even as he is righteous.

8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of Yahweh was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

9 Whosoever is born of Elohim doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of Elohim.

10 In this the children of Elohim are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of Elohim, neither he that loveth not his brother.

11 For this is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should love one another.

6 And the apostles and elders
came together for to consider
of this matter.

7 And when there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, ye know how that a good while ago Elohim made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the good news, and believe.

**Peter was the first apostle
to the Gentiles.**

Acts 10:1-48

God spoke all these words.

in the LORD your God. Who brought you out of Egypt out of the land of slaves.

shall have no other gods before me.

shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall bow down to them as to idols. You shall not follow the son of the father to the fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my command.

shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God for the LORD will not hold you guiltless for misuse of his name.

remember the Sabbath day, keeping it holy. In six days you shall labor and do all your work. But the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your man or woman or maid or servant, nor your animal, nor any other of your livestock. For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day, and made it holy.

honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you.

9 And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith.
