Galatians 1

1 Paul, an apostle, (not of
men, neither by man, but by
Yahshua Messiah, and
Yahweh the Father, who
raised him from the dead;)

Galatians 1

2 And all the brethren which
are with me, unto the
assemblies of Galatia:

3 Grace be to you and peace
from Yahweh the Father, and
from our Master Yahshua
Messiah,

Galatians 1

4 Who gave himself for our
sins, that he might deliver us
from this present evil world,
according to the will of El and
our Father:

5 To whom be glory for ever
and ever. Amen.

Galatians 1

6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Messiah unto another good news:

7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the good news of Messiah.

Galatians 1

Acts 15:24

24 Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment:

**Circumcision is

8 But though we, or **an angel from heaven**, preach any other good news unto you than that which we have preached unto you, **let him be accursed.**

Galatians 1

Deuteronomy 17:9-13

9 And thou shalt come unto the priests the Levites, and unto the judge that shall be in those days, and enquire; **and they shall shew thee the sentence of judgment:**

10 **And thou shalt do according to the sentence,** which they of that place which Yahweh shall choose shall shew thee; and thou shalt observe to do according to all that they inform thee:

11 According to the sentence of the law which they shall teach thee, and according to the judgment which they shall tell thee, thou shalt do: thou shalt not decline from the sentence which they shall shew thee, to the right hand, nor to the left.

12 And the man that will do presumptuously, and **will not hearken** unto the priest that standeth to minister there before Yahweh thy Elohim, or unto the judge, even **that man shall die:** and thou shalt put away the evil from Israel.

13 **And all the people shall hear, and fear, and do no more presumptuously.**

9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other good news unto you than that ye have received, **let him be accursed.**

10 For do I now persuade men, or Elohim? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Messiah.

Galatians 1

11 But I certify you, brethren,
that the good news which
was preached of me is not
after man.

12 For I neither received it of
man, neither was I taught it,
but by the revelation of
Yahshua Messiah.

Galatians 1

13 For ye have heard of my conversation in time past in the Jews' religion, how that beyond measure I persecuted the assembly of Yahweh, and wasted it:

14 And profited in the Jews' religion above many my equals in mine own nation, being more exceedingly zealous of the traditions of my fathers.

Galatians 1

15 But when it pleased Elohim,
who separated me from my
mother's womb, and called me
by his grace,

16 To reveal his Son in me, that
I might preach him among the
heathen; **immediately I**
conferred not with flesh and
blood:

Galatians 1

17 Neither went I up to
Jerusalem to them which were
apostles before me; but I went
into Arabia, and returned again
unto Damascus.

18 Then after three years I
went up to Jerusalem to see
Peter, and abode with him
fifteen days.

Galatians 1

19 But other of the apostles
saw I none, save James the
Master's brother.

20 Now the things which I
write unto you, behold,
before Elohim, I lie not.

Galatians 1

21 Afterwards I came into the
regions of Syria and Cilicia;

22 And was unknown by face
unto the assemblies of
Judaea which were in
Messiah:

Galatians 1

23 But they had heard only,
That he which persecuted us
in times past now preacheth
the faith which once he
destroyed.

24 And they glorified Elohim
in me.

Galatians 2

1 Then fourteen years after I went up again to Jerusalem with **Barnabas**, and took **Titus** with me also.

2 And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that good news which I preach among the **Gentiles**, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in vain.

Galatians 2

Acts 15:2

2 When therefore **Paul and Barnabas** had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that **Paul and Barnabas**, and **certain other of them**, should go up to Jerusalem unto the apostles and elders about this question.

1 Then fourteen years after I
went up again to Jerusalem
with **Barnabas**, and took **Titus**
with me also.

Galatians 2

3 But neither **Titus**, who was
with me, being a Greek, was
compelled **to be circumcised**:

Galatians 2

4 And that because of **false brethren** unawares brought in, who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Messiah Yahshua, that they might bring us into bondage:

5 To whom we gave place by subjection, no, **not for an hour**; that the truth of the good news might continue with you.

Galatians 2

6 But of these who seemed
to be somewhat, (whatsoever
they were, it maketh no
matter to me: Elohim
accepteth no man's person:)
for they who seemed to be
somewhat in conference
added nothing to me:

Galatians 2

7 But contrariwise, when they saw
that the good news of the
uncircumcision was committed
unto me, as the good news of the
circumcision was unto Peter;

8 (For he that wrought effectually
in Peter to the apostleship of the
circumcision, the same was mighty
in me toward the Gentiles:)

Galatians 2

9 And when James, Cephas,
and John, who seemed to be
pillars, perceived the grace that
was given unto me, **they gave
to me and Barnabas the right
hands of fellowship;** that we
should go unto the heathen,
and they unto the circumcision.
