

THE POWER OF

The manifestation of

Psalms

19:1-2

1) The heavens declare the glory of El;
and the firmament sheweth his
handywork.

2) Day unto day uttereth speech, and
night unto night sheweth knowledge.

Psalms

33:6-9

6) By the word of Yahweh were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.

7) He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the depth in storehouses.

8) Let all the earth fear Yahweh: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.

9) For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.

Isaiah 40:21

Have ye not known? have ye not
heard? hath it not been told you from
the beginning? have ye not
understood from the foundations of
the earth?

John 1:3

All things were made by him; and
without him was not any thing made
that was made.

Our earth owes its existence to
Elohim who through whatever means
and process He saw fit to create the
world.

Genesis 1

1, 3, 6-7, 9-11, 14,
20, 24, 26-29

Psalms

111:1-6

1) Praise ye Yah. I will praise Yahweh with my whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and in the congregation.

2) The works of Yahweh are great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein.

3) His work is honourable and glorious: and his righteousness endureth for ever.

4) He hath made his wonderful works to be remembered: Yahweh is gracious and full of compassion.

5) He hath given meat unto them that fear him: he will ever be mindful of his covenant.

6) He hath shewed his people the power of his works, that he may give them the heritage of the heathen.

Psalms

71:17-19

17) O Elohim, thou hast taught me from my youth: and hitherto have I declared thy wondrous works.

18) Now also when I am old and grayheaded, O Elohim, forsake me not; until I have shewed thy strength unto this generation, and thy POWER to every one that is to come.

19) Thy righteousness also, O Elohim, is very high, who hast done great things: O Elohim, who is like unto thee!

Psalm

77:10-14

10) And I said, This is my infirmity: but I will remember
the years of the right hand of the most High.

11) I will remember the works of Yah: surely I will
remember thy wonders of old.

12) I will meditate also of all thy work, and talk of thy
doings.

13) Thy way, O Elohim, is in the sanctuary:
who is so great a El as our Elohim?

14) Thou art the El that doest wonders: thou
hast declared thy strength among the
people.

Elohim has the POWER to
accomplish anything that can be
accomplished!

Exodus 19

Verse 5, 9, 16-20

5) Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine:

9) And Yahweh said unto Moses, Lo, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with thee, and believe thee for ever. And Moses told the words of the people unto Yahweh.

16) And it came to pass on the third day in the morning, that there were thunders and lightnings, and a thick cloud upon the mount, and the voice of the trumpet exceeding loud; so that all the people that was in the camp trembled.

17) And Moses brought forth the people out of the camp to meet with Elohim; and they stood at the nether part of the mount.

18) And mount Sinai was altogether on a smoke, because Yahweh descended upon it in fire: and the smoke thereof ascended as the smoke of a furnace, and the whole mount quaked greatly.

19) And when the voice of the trumpet sounded long, and waxed louder and louder, Moses spake, and Elohim answered him by a voice.

20) And Yahweh came down upon mount Sinai, on the top of the mount: and Yahweh called Moses up to the top of the mount; and Moses went up.

Exodus

20:18-19

18) And all the people saw the thunders, and the lightnings, and the noise of the trumpet, and the mountain smoking: and when the people saw it, they removed, and stood afar off.

19) And they said unto Moses, Speak thou with us, and we will hear: but let not Elohim speak with us, lest we die.

Isaiah

44:6-8

6) Thus saith Yahweh the King of Israel, and his redeemer Yahweh of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no Elohim.

7) And who, as I, shall call, and shall declare it, and set it in order for me, since I appointed the ancient people? and the things that are coming, and shall come, let them shew unto them.

8) Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a Eloah beside me? yea, there is no refuge; I know not any.

Isaiah

44:24-27

24) Thus saith Yahweh, thy redeemer, and he that formed thee from the womb, I am Yahweh that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself;

25) That frustrateth the tokens of the liars, and maketh diviners mad; that turneth wise men backward, and maketh their knowledge foolish;

26) That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers; that saith to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah, Ye shall be built, and I will raise up the decayed places thereof:

27) That saith to the deep, Be dry, and I will dry up thy rivers:

Isaiah

45:5-7,18

5) I am Yahweh, and there is none else, there is no Elohim beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me:

6) That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that there is none beside me. I am Yahweh, and there is none else.

7) I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I Yahweh do all these things.

18) For thus saith Yahweh that created the heavens; Elohim himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am Yahweh; and there is none else.

Isaiah

46:5, 9-11

5) To whom will ye liken me, and make
me equal, and compare me, that we
may be like?

9) Remember the former things of old: for I am El, and there is none else; I am Elohim, and there is none like me,

10) Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure:

11) Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executeth my counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it.

Isaiah
43:1-13

1) But now thus saith Yahweh that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art mine.

2) When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.

3) For I am Yahweh thy Elohim, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.

4) Since thou wast precious in my sight, thou hast been honourable, and I have loved thee: therefore will I give men for thee, and people for thy life.

5) Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west;

6) I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth;

7) Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for my glory, I have formed him; yea, I have made him.

8) Bring forth the blind people that have eyes, and the deaf that have ears.

9) Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and shew us former things? let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, It is truth.

10) Ye are my witnesses, saith Yahweh, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no El formed, neither shall there be after me.

11) I, even I, am Yahweh; and beside me there is no saviour.

12) I have declared, and have saved, and I have shewed, when there was no strange elohim among you: therefore ye are my witnesses, saith Yahweh, that I am El.

13) Yea, before the day was I am he; and there is none that can deliver out of my hand: I will work, and who shall let it?

14) Thus saith Yahweh, your redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; For your sake I have sent to Babylon, and have brought down all their nobles, and the Chaldeans, whose cry is in the ships.

15) I am Yahweh, your Holy One, the creator of Israel, your King.

16) Thus saith Yahweh, which maketh a way in the sea, and a path in the mighty waters;

Psalms

145:1-21

1) I will extol thee, my Elohim, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.

2) Every day will I bless thee; and I will praise thy name for ever and ever.

3) Great is Yahweh, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is unsearchable.

4) One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts.

5) I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works.

6) And men shall speak of the might of thy terrible acts: and I will declare thy greatness.

7) They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy
great goodness, and shall sing of thy
righteousness.

8) Yahweh is gracious, and full of compassion; slow
to anger, and of great mercy.

9) Yahweh is good to all: and his tender mercies are
over all his works.

10) All thy works shall praise thee, O Yahweh; and thy saints shall bless thee.

11) They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;

12) To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom.

13) Thy kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion endureth throughout all generations.

14) Yahweh upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down.

15) The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season.

16) Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing.

17) Yahweh is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.

18) Yahweh is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.

19) He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

20) Yahweh preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.

21) My mouth shall speak the praise of Yahweh: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.

Genesis

18:11-14

11) Now Abraham and Sarah were old and well stricken in age; and it ceased to be with Sarah after the manner of women.

12) Therefore Sarah laughed within herself, saying, After I am waxed old shall I have pleasure, my sovereign being old also?

13) And Yahweh said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old?

14) Is any thing too hard for Yahweh? At the time appointed I will return unto thee, according to the time of life, and Sarah shall have a son.

Numbers

11:21-23

21) And Moses said, The people, among whom I am, are six hundred thousand footmen; and thou hast said, I will give them flesh, that they may eat a whole month.

22) Shall the flocks and the herds be slain for them, to suffice them? or shall all the fish of the sea be gathered together for them, to suffice them?

23) And Yahweh said unto Moses, Is Yahweh's hand waxed short? thou shalt see now whether my word shall come to pass unto thee or not.

Jeremiah 32:17

Ah my Sovereign Yahweh! behold,
thou hast made the heaven and the
earth by thy great power and
stretched out arm, and there is
nothing too hard for thee:

Psalms 115:3

But our Elohim is in the heavens: he
hath done whatsoever he hath
pleased.

It takes the power of
Yahweh to bring somebody
salvation.

Matthew

19:23-26

23) Then said Yahshua unto his disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.

24) And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of Yahweh.

25) When his disciples heard it, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be saved?

26) But Yahshua beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; BUT WITH YAHWEH ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE.

It took the POWER of YAHWEH to
raise YAHSHUA from the dead.

Matthew

28:1-6

1) In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.

2) And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of Yahweh descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it.

3) His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow:

4) And for fear of him the keepers did shake, and became as dead men.

5) And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Yahshua, which was impaled.

6) He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Master lay.

Is there anything to HARD or
IMPOSSIBLE for YAHWEH?

(Mark 10:27, Luke 1:37)

Mark 10:27

And Yahshua looking upon them
saith, With men it is impossible, but
not with Elohim: for with Elohim ALL
THINGS ARE POSSIBLE.

Luke 1:37

For with Elohim NOTHING SHALL
BE IMPOSSIBLE.

Jeremíah

10:10-12

10) But Yahweh is the true Elohim, he is the living Elohim, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.

11) Thus shall ye say unto them, The mighty ones that have not made the heavens and the earth, even they shall perish from the earth, and from under these heavens.

12) He hath made the earth by his POWER, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heavens by his discretion.
