## Psalms 110:1-4

- 1 Yahweh said unto my **Sovereign**, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- 2 Yahweh shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies.
- 3 Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth.
- 4 Yahweh hath sworn, and will not repent, **Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.**

## **Hebrews 6:13-20**

13 For when Elohim made promise to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself, 14 Saying Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee.

15 And so, after he had patiently endured he obtained the promise.

16 For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife.

17 Wherein Elohim, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath:

18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for Elohim to lie we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us



19 Which hope we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;  
20 Whither the forerunner is for us entered even Yahshua, made an high priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec.

## Hebrews 7:1-

1 For this Melchisedec, **king of Salem,** **priest** of the most high Elohim, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him;

2 To whom also Abraham gave **a tenth part of all;** first being by interpretation **King of righteousness,** and after that also **King of Salem,** which is **King of peace;**

3 Without father, without mother,  
without descent, having neither  
beginning of days, nor end of life;  
but made like unto the Son of  
Elohim; abideth a priest continually.

4 **Now consider how great this man  
was,** unto whom even the patriarch  
Abraham gave the tenth of the  
spoils.

## Micah 5:1-2

1 Now gather thyself in troops, O daughter of troops: he hath laid siege against us: they shall smite the judge of Israel with a rod upon the cheek.

2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

4 Now consider how great this man was, unto whom even the patriarch Abraham gave the tenth of the spoils.

5 And verily they that are of the sons of Levi, who receive the office of the priesthood, have a commandment to take tithes of the people according to the law, that is of their brethren, though they come out of the loins of Abraham:

6 But he whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises.

7 And without all contradiction the  
less is blessed of the better.

8 And here men that die receive  
tithes; but there he receiveth them,  
of whom it is witnessed that he liveth

9 And as I may so say Levi also, who  
receiveth tithes, payed tithes in  
Abraham.

10 For he was yet in the loins of his  
father, when Melchisedec met him.

11 If therefore perfection were by the Levitical priesthood, under it the people received the law what further need was there that another priest should rise after the order of Melchisedec, and not be called after the order of Aaron?

12 For the priesthood being changed there is made of necessity a change also of the law.

## Matthew 5:17-18

17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.

18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.



## Deuteronomy 4:2

**Ye shall not** add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of Yahweh your Elohim which I command you.

## Exodus 32:1-25

1 And when the people saw that Moses delayed to come down out of the mount, the people gathered themselves together **unto Aaron**, and said unto **him**, Up, make us mighty ones, which shall go before us; for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

2 **And Aaron said unto them,** Break off the golden earrings, which are in the ears of your wives, of your sons, and of your daughters, and bring them **unto me.**

3 And all the people brake off the golden earrings which were in their ears, and **brought them unto Aaron.**

4 And he received them at their hand, and fashioned it with a graving tool, after he had made it a molten calf: and they said, These be thy mighty ones, O Israel, which brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

5 And when Aaron saw it, he built an altar before it; and Aaron made proclamation, and said, To morrow is a feast to Yahweh.

6 And they rose up early on the morrow, and offered burnt offerings, and brought peace offerings; and the people sat down to eat and to drink, and rose up to play.

7 And Yahweh said unto Moses, Go, get thee down; for thy people, which thou broughtest out of the land of Egypt, have corrupted themselves:

8 They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These be thy mighty ones, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

9 And Yahweh said unto Moses, I have seen this people, and, behold, it is a stiffnecked people:

10 Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may wax hot against them, and that I may consume them: and I will make of thee a great nation.

11 And Moses besought Yahweh his Elohim, and said, Yahweh, why doth thy wrath wax hot against thy people, which thou hast brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?



12 Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from thy fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against thy people.

13 Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, thy servants, to whom thou swarest by thine own self, and saidst unto them, I will multiply your seed as the stars of heaven, and all this land that I have spoken of will I give unto your seed, and they shall inherit it for ever.

14 And Yahweh repented of the evil which he thought to do unto his people.

15 And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written.

16 And the tables were the work of Elohim, and the writing was the writing of Elohim, graven upon the tables.

17 And when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said unto Moses, There is a noise of war in the camp.

18 And he said, It is not the voice of them that shout for mastery, neither is it the voice of them that cry for being overcome: but the noise of them that sing do I hear.

19 And it came to pass, as soon as he came nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf, and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed hot, and he cast the tables out of his hands, and brake them beneath the mount.

20 And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt it in the fire, and ground it to powder, and strawed it upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink of it.

21 And Moses said unto Aaron, **What did this people unto thee, that thou hast brought so great a sin upon them?**

22 And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my sovereign wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they are set on mischief.

23 For they said unto me, Make us mighty ones, which shall go before us: for as for this Moses, the man that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, we wot not what is become of him.

24 And I said unto them,  
Whosoever hath any gold, let  
them break it off. So they gave it  
me: then I cast it into the fire,  
and there came out this calf.  
25 And when Moses saw that the  
people were naked; (for Aaron  
had made them naked unto their  
shame among their enemies:)

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The Priest is the one who helps with the intimacy between Elohim and His people because he is the one who teaches Torah Yahweh's like and dislike
