Deuteronomy 25:4

Thou shalt not muzzle the ox
when he treadeth out the corn.



1 Corinthians 9:5-10

5 Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife, as well as other apostles, and as the brethren of the Master, and Cephas?

6 Or I only and Barnabas, have not we power to forbear working?

7 Who goeth a warfare any time
at his own charges? who
planteth a vineyard, and eateth
not of the fruit thereof? or who
feedeth a flock, and eateth not
of the milk of the flock?

8 Say I these things as a man?
or saith not the law the same
also?

9 For it is written in the law of Moses,
Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of
the ox that treadeth out the corn.

Doth Elohim take care for oxen?

10 Or saith he it altogether for our
sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, this
is written: that he that ploweth
should plow in hope; and that he that
thresheth in hope should be partaker
of his hope.

1 Timothy 5:17-18

17 Let the elders that rule well be counted worthy of double honour, especially they who labour in the word and doctrine.

18 For the scripture saith **Thou shalt not muzzle the ox that treadeth out the corn.** And, The labourer is worthy of his reward.

Deuteronomy 6:1-8

1 Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which Yahweh your Elohim commanded to teach you, that ye might do them in the land whither ye go to possess it:

2 That thou mightest fear Yahweh thy Elohim, to keep all his statutes and his commandments, which I command thee, thou, and thy son, and thy son's son, all the days of thy life; and that thy days may be prolonged.

3 Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe to do it; that it may be well with thee, and that ye may increase mightily, as Yahweh Elohim of thy fathers hath promised thee, in the land that floweth with milk and honey.

The Shema

4 Hear, O Israel: Yahweh our Elohim
is one Yahweh:

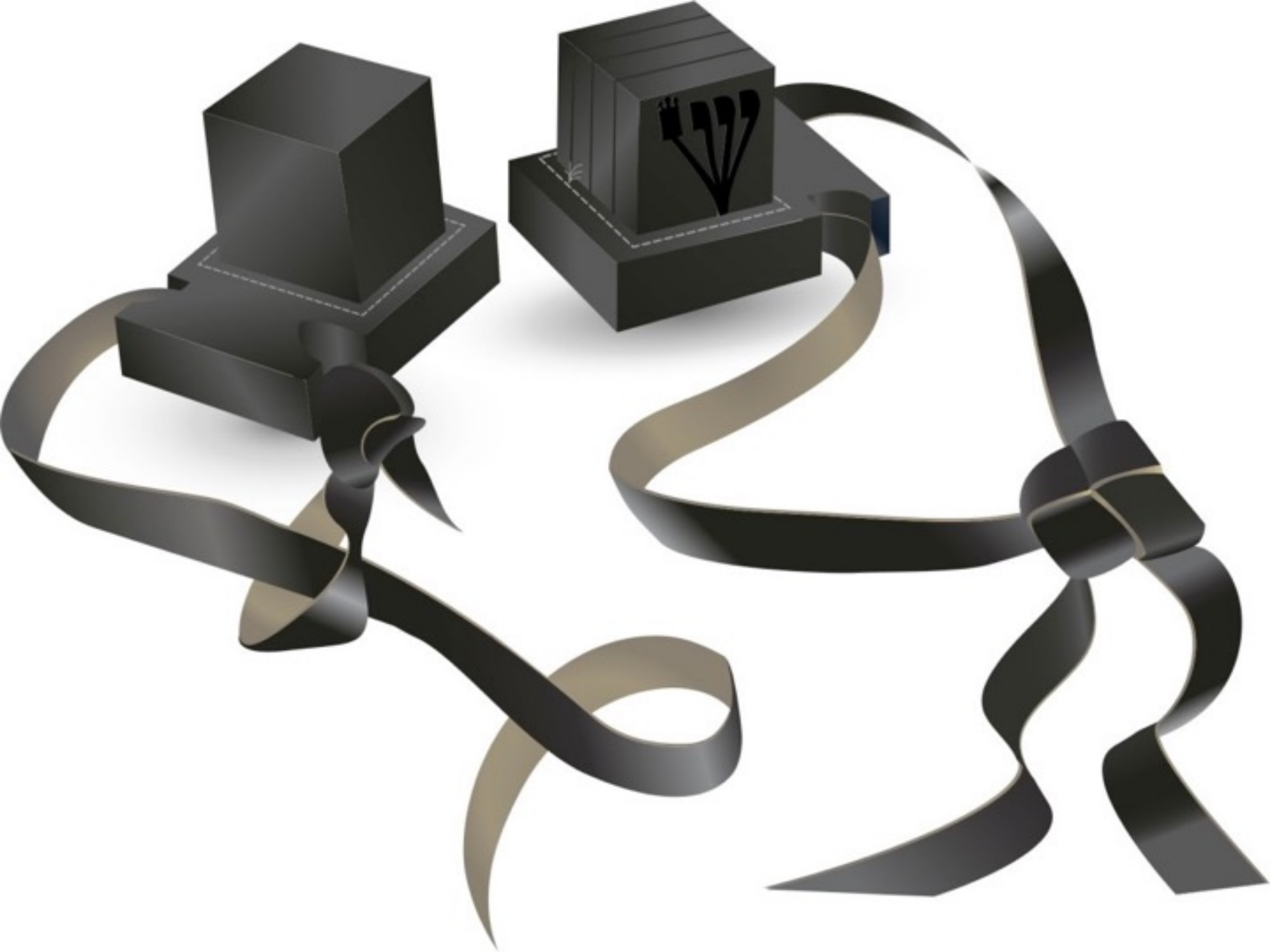
5 And thou shalt love Yahweh thy
Elohim with all thine heart, and with
all thy soul, and with all thy might.

6 And these words, which I
command thee this day, shall be in
thine heart:

7 And thou shalt teach them diligently unto thy children, and shalt talk of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, and when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

8 And thou shalt bind them for a sign upon thine hand, and they shall be as frontlets between thine eyes.





Revelation 13:1-18

1 And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.

2 And the beast which I saw was like unto a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his seat, and great authority.

3 And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast.

4 And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?

5 And there was given unto him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given unto him to continue forty and two months.

6 And he opened his mouth in blasphemy against Yahweh, to blaspheme his name, and his tabernacle, and them that dwell in heaven.

7 And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations.

8 And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

9 If any man have an ear, let him hear.

10 He that leadeth into captivity shall go into captivity: he that killeth with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

11 And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.

12 And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

13 And he doeth great wonders, so that he maketh fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men,

14 And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.

15 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

16 And he causeth all, both
small and great, rich and poor,
free and bond, to receive a mark
in their right hand, or in their
foreheads:

17 And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

18 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is **Six hundred threescore and six.**

1 And Yahweh spake unto
Moses, saying,
2 Sanctify unto me all the
firstborn, whatsoever
openeth the womb

Israel, both of man and
of beast: it is mine.

3 And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand Yahweh brought you out from this place: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

4 This day came ye out in the month Abib.

5 And it shall be when Yahweh shall bring thee into the land of the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, which he sware unto thy fathers to give thee, a land flowing with milk and honey, that thou shalt keep this service in this month.

6 Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened bread, and in the seventh day shall be a feast to Yahweh.

7 Unleavened bread shall be eaten seven days; and there shall no leavened bread be seen with thee, neither shall there be leaven seen with thee in all thy quarters.

8 And thou shalt shew thy son in that day, saying, This is done because of that which Yahweh did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt.

9 And it shall be for a sign
unto thee upon thine hand,
and for a memorial between
thine eyes, that Yahweh's law
may be in thy mouth: for with
a strong hand hath Yahweh
brought thee out of Egypt.

10 Thou shalt therefore keep
this ordinance in his season
from year to year.

What you say and do matters, the fact that you remember Passover and how Yahweh delivered you from bondage, is like binding them as a sign on your hand and frontlet between your eyes.

Exodus 13:11-18

11 And it shall be when Yahweh shall bring thee into the land of the Canaanites, as he sware unto thee and to thy fathers, and shall give it thee,

12 That thou shalt set apart unto Yahweh all that openeth the matrix, and every firstling that cometh of a beast which thou hast; the males shall be Yahweh's.

13 And every firstling of a donkey thou shalt redeem with a lamb; and if thou wilt not redeem it, then thou shalt break his neck: and all the firstborn of man among thy children shalt thou redeem.

14 And it shall be when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What is this? that thou shalt say unto him, By strength of hand Yahweh brought us out from Egypt, from the house of bondage:

15 And it came to pass, when Pharaoh would hardly let us go, that Yahweh slew all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both the firstborn of man, and the firstborn of beast: therefore I sacrifice to Yahweh all that openeth the matrix, being males; but all the firstborn of my children I redeem.

16 And it shall be for a token upon thine hand, and for frontlets between thine eyes: for by strength of hand Yahweh brought us forth out of Egypt.

17 And it came to pass, when Pharaoh had let the people go, that Elohim led them not through the way of the land of the Philistines, although that was near; for Elohim said, Lest peradventure the people repent when they see war, and they return to Egypt:

18 But Elohim led the people about, through the way of the wilderness of the Red sea: and the children of Israel went up harnessed out of the land of Egypt.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9

4 Hear, O Israel: Yahweh
our Elohim is one Yahweh:

5 And thou shalt love
Yahweh thy Elohim with all
thine heart, and with all thy
soul, and with all thy might.

6 And these words, which I
command thee this day,
shall be in thine heart:

Deuteronomy 11:13-21

13 And it shall come to pass, if ye shall hearken diligently unto my commandments which I command you this day, to love Yahweh your Elohim, and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul,
14 That I will give you the rain of your land in his due season, the first rain and the latter rain, that thou mayest gather in thy corn, and thy wine, and thine oil.

15 And I will send grass in thy fields for thy cattle, that thou mayest eat and be full.

16 Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and ye turn aside, and serve other mighty ones, and worship them;

17 And then Yahweh's wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heaven, that there be no rain, and that the land yield not her fruit; and lest ye perish quickly from off the good land which Yahweh giveth you.

18 Therefore shall ye lay up these my words in your heart and in your soul, and bind them for a sign upon your hand, that they may be as frontlets between your eyes.

19 And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

20 And thou shalt write them upon the door posts of thine house, and upon thy gates:

21 That your days may be multiplied, and the days of your children, in the land which Yahweh swore unto your fathers to give them, as the days of heaven upon the earth.

Deuteronomy 6:20-25

20 And when thy son asketh thee in time to come, saying, What mean the testimonies, and the statutes, and the judgments, which Yahweh our Elohim hath commanded you?

21 Then thou shalt say unto thy son, We were Pharaoh's bondmen in Egypt; and Yahweh brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand:

22 And Yahweh shewed signs
and wonders, great and sore,
upon Egypt, upon Pharaoh, and
upon all his household, before
our eyes:

23 And he brought us out from
thence, that he might bring us
in, to give us the land which he
sware unto our fathers.

24 And Yahweh commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear Yahweh our Elohim, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as it is at this day.

25 And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before Yahweh our Elohim, as he hath commanded us.

Revelation 12:17

And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, **which keep the commandments of Yahweh, and have the testimony of Yahshua Messiah.**

Luke 9:61-62

61 And another also said, Master, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house.

62 And Yahshua said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of Yahweh.

Deuteronomy 6:9

9 And thou shalt write

gates.



Deuteronomy 7:26

Neither shalt thou bring an abomination **into thine house,** lest thou be a cursed thing like it: but thou shalt utterly detest it, and thou shalt utterly abhor it; for it is a cursed thing.

Jeremiah 17:21-22

21 Thus saith Yahweh; Take heed to yourselves, and bear no burden on the sabbath day, nor bring it in **by the gates of Jerusalem;**

22 Neither carry forth a burden **out of your houses** on the sabbath day, neither do ye any work, but hallow ye the sabbath day, as I commanded your fathers.

Let not mercy and truth
forsake thee: **bind them**
about thy neck; **write**

14 Then came to him the disciples of John, saying, Why do we and the Pharisees fast oft, but thy disciples fast not?

15 And Yahshua said unto them, Can the children of the bridechamber mourn, as long as the bridegroom is with them? but the days will come, when the bridegroom shall be taken from them, and then shall they fast.

9 Thou shalt not sow thy

Isaiah 5:7

For the vineyard of Yahweh of
hosts is the house of Israel,
and the men of Judah his
pleasant plant: and he looked
for judgment, but behold
oppression; for righteousness,
but behold a cry.

Ezra 9:1-2

1 Now when these things were done, the princes came to me, saying, The people of Israel, and the priests, and the Levites, have not separated themselves from the people of the lands, doing according to their abominations, even of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Perizzites, the Jebusites, the Ammonites, the Moabites, the Egyptians, and the Amorites.

1 Now in the twenty and fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, and with sackclothes, and earth upon them.

2 **And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers,** and stood and confessed their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers.

Matthew 13:24-25

24 Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, **The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field:**

25 But while men slept, his enemy came and **sowed tares** among the wheat, and went his way.

Ezra 4:1-2

1 Now when the **adversaries** of Judah and Benjamin heard that the children of the captivity builded the temple unto Yahweh Elohim of Israel;

2 Then they came to Zerubbabel, and to the chief of the fathers, and said unto them, **Let us build with you: for we seek your Elohim, as ye do;** and we do sacrifice unto him since the days of Esarhaddon king of Assur, which brought us up hither.

11 Thou shalt not wear a garment of divers sorts, as of woollen and linen together.

Revelation 3:4

Thou hast a few names
even in Sardis which **have**
not defiled their
garments; and they shall

2 Corinthians 6:14-

14 Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?

15 And what concord hath Messiah with Belial? or what part hath he that believeth with an infidel?

16 And what agreement hath the temple of Elohim with idols? for ye are the temple of the living Elohim; as Elohim hath said, I will dwell in them, and walk in them; and I will be their Elohim, and they shall be my people.

17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith Yahweh, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you,
18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith Yahweh Almighty.
