A Study Through The Book Of GALATIANS

14 For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

15 But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

Galatians 5

Romans 7:12-14

12 Wherefore **the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.**

13 **Was then that which is good made death unto me? Certainly not.** But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful.

14 For we know that **the law is spiritual:** but I am carnal, sold under sin.

Nehemiah 9:6-21

6 Thou, even thou, art Yahweh alone; thou hast made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and all that is therein, and thou preservest them all; and the host of heaven worshippeth thee.

7 Thou art Yahweh the Elohim, who didst choose Abram, and broughtest him forth out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gavest him the name of Abraham;

8 And foundest his heart faithful before thee, and madest a covenant with him to give the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Jebusites, and the Girgashites, to give it, I say, to his seed, and hast performed thy words; for thou art righteous:

9 And didst see the affliction of our fathers in Egypt, and heardest their cry by the Red sea;

10 And shewedst signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for thou knewest that they dealt proudly against them. So didst thou get thee a name, as it is this day.

11 And thou didst divide the sea before them, so that they went through the midst of the sea on the dry land; and their persecutors thou threwest into the deeps, as a stone into the mighty waters.

12 Moreover thou leddest them in the day by a cloudy pillar; and in the night by a pillar of fire, to give them light in the way wherein they should go.

13 Thou camest down also upon mount Sinai, and spakest with them from heaven, and gavest them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments:

14 And madest known unto them
thy holy sabbath, and
commandedst them precepts,
statutes, and laws, by the hand of
Moses thy servant:

15 And gavest them bread from
heaven for their hunger, and
broughtest forth water for them
out of the rock for their thirst, and
promisedst them that they should
go in to possess the land which
thou hadst sworn to give them.

16 But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments,

17 And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou art a Eloah ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

18 Yea, when they had made them a molten calf, and said, This is thy mighty one that brought thee up out of Egypt, and had wrought great provocations;

19 Yet thou in thy manifold mercies forsookest them not in the wilderness: the pillar of the cloud departed not from them by day, to lead them in the way; neither the pillar of fire by night, to shew them light, and the way wherein they should go.

20 Thou gavest also **thy good spirit to instruct them,** and withheldest not thy manna from their mouth, and gavest them water for their thirst.

21 Yea, forty years didst thou sustain them in the wilderness, so that they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not.

Nehemiah 9:26-30

26 Nevertheless they were disobedient, and rebelled against thee, and **cast thy law behind their backs**, and slew thy prophets which testified against them to turn them to thee, and they wrought great provocations.

27 Therefore thou deliveredst them into the hand of their enemies, who vexed them: and in the time of their trouble, when they cried unto thee, thou heardest them from heaven; and according to thy manifold mercies thou gavest them saviours, who saved them out of the hand of their enemies.

28 But after they had rest,
they did evil again before
thee: therefore leftest thou
them in the hand of their
enemies, so that they had the
dominion over them: yet
when they returned, and cried
unto thee, thou heardest
them from heaven; and many
times didst thou deliver them
according to thy mercies;

29 And testifiedst against them, **that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law:** yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.

30 Yet many years didst
thou forbear them, and
testifiedst against them
by thy spirit in thy
prophets: yet would they
not give ear: therefore
gavest thou them into the
hand of the people of the
lands.

Psalms 119

1 Blessed are the undefiled in the way, **who walk in the law of Yahweh.**

35 Make me to **go in the path of thy commandments;** for therein do I delight.

59 I thought on my ways, and **turned my feet unto thy testimonies.**

Psalms 85:13

Righteousness shall go
before him; and **shall set
us in the way of his
steps.**

Romans 8:1-4

1 There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Messiah Yahshua, ~~who walk not after the flesh, but~~ **after the Spirit.**

2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Messiah Yahshua hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

3 For what the law could not do, in that it was **weak through the flesh**, Yahweh sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, **who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.**

Matthew 7:22-23

22 Many will say to me in that day, Master, Master, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?

23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity (those who practice lawlessness).

1 John 1:1-6

1 That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked upon and our hands have handled, of the Word of life;

2 (For the life was manifested, and we have seen it, and bear witness, and shew unto you that eternal life, which was with the Father, and was manifested unto us;)

3 That which we have seen and heard declare we unto you, that ye also may have fellowship with us: and truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Yahshua Messiah.

4 And these things write we unto you, that your joy may be full.

5 This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that Elohim is light, and in him is no darkness at all.

6 If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:

1 John 2:3-4

3 And hereby we do know
that we know him, if we
keep his commandments.

4 He that saith, I know
him, and keepeth not his
commandments, is a liar,
and the truth is not in
him.

7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Yahshua Messiah his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

Romans 8:5-14

5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.

6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against Elohim: for it is not subject to the law of Elohim, neither indeed can be.

8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please Elohim.

9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that **the Spirit of Elohim** dwell in you. Now if any man have not **the Spirit of Messiah**, he is none of his.

10 And if Messiah be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.

11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Yahshua from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Messiah from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of Elohim, they are the sons of Elohim.

16 This I say then, **Walk in the Spirit**, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

17 **For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh:** and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.

Galatians 5

1 Timothy 6:11-12

11 But thou, O man of Elohim, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, holiness, faith, love, patience, meekness.

12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.

2 Timothy 4:6-8

6 For I am now ready to be offered, and the time of my departure is at hand.

7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith:

8 Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Master, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that love his appearing.

2 Timothy 2:1-


1 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Messiah Yahshua.

2 And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.

3 Thou therefore endure hardness,
as a good soldier of Yahshua
Messiah.

4 No man that warreth entangleth
himself with the affairs of this life;
that he may please him who hath
chosen him to be a soldier.

5 And if a man also strive for
masteries, yet is he not crowned,
except he strive lawfully.
