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Romans 1:18-23

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20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Majesty; so that they are without excuse:

21 Because that, when they knew Elohim, they glorified him not as Elohim, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Leviticus 23:9-14



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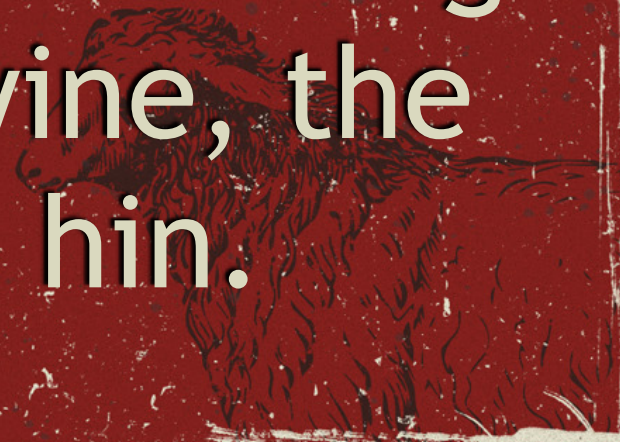
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10 Speak unto the children of Israel,

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

1 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the good news which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;
2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.



3 For I delivered unto you first
of all that which I also
received, how that Messiah
died for our sins according to
the scriptures;

4 And that he was buried, and
that he rose again the third day
according to the scriptures:

12 Now if Messiah be
preached that he rose from
the dead, how say some
among you that there is no
resurrection of the dead?



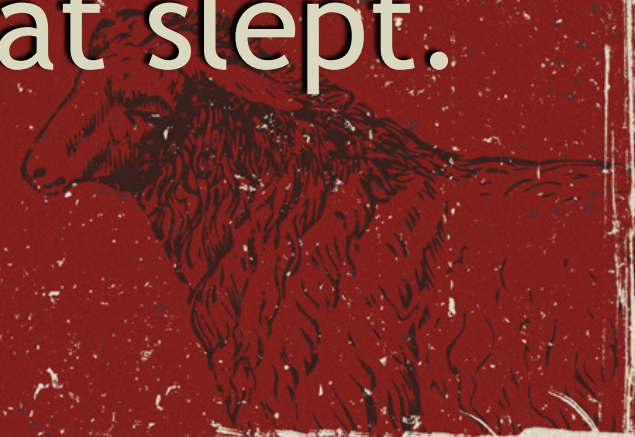
13 But if there be no
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14 And if Messiah be not
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19 If in this life only we have hope in Messiah, we are of all men most miserable.

20 But now is Messiah risen from the dead, *and* become the firstfruits of them that slept.



21 For since by man *came*
death, by man *came* also the
resurrection of the dead.

22 For as in Adam all die,
even so in Messiah shall all be
made alive.



23 But every man in his own order: Messiah the firstfruits; afterward they that are Messiah's at his coming.



Job 19:25-26

25 For I know *that* my redeemer
liveth, and *that* he shall stand at
the latter *day* upon the earth:

26 And *though* after my skin
worms destroy this *body*, yet in
my flesh shall I see Eloah:



Isaiah 26:19

Thy dead *men* shall live,
together with my dead body
shall they arise. Awake and sing,
ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew
is as the dew of herbs, and the
earth shall cast out the dead.



Daniel 12:2

And many of them that sleep
in the dust of the earth shall
awake, some to everlasting
life, and some to shame *and*
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In his book 'Thus shalt thou
serve' C.W Slemming writes
this little interesting point:



When the sheaves were cut from the fields and carried to the city, small vacant spots were left behind. When Yahshua rose from the dead, He left behind Him a small vacant spot, which still remains as a reminder of His resurrection - it is an empty tomb!'

It took the resurrection of
Yahshua to make us
acceptable to Elohim.

Romans 4:25
Who was delivered for our
offences, and was raised
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1 Corinthians 15:17-18

17 And if Messiah be not raised,
your faith *is* vain; ye are yet in
your sins.

18 Then they also which are
fallen asleep in Messiah are
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Yahshua resurrection is a
GUARANTEE of our
resurrection (as long as we
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He has been raised and has a new resurrection body but the same will happen to all that are His at the right time. And that right time is the return of Yahshua for His bride




1 Corinthians 15:41-58

41 *There is one glory of the sun,
and another glory of the moon,
and another glory of the stars: for
one star differeth from another
star in glory.*

42 So also *is* the resurrection of
the dead. It is sown in corruption;
it is raised in incorruption:

43 It is sown in dishonour; it
is raised in glory: it is sown in
weakness; it is raised in
power:

44 It is sown a natural body;
it is raised a spiritual body.
There is a natural body, and
there is a spiritual body.



45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam *was made* a quickening spirit.


46 Howbeit that *was* not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.

47 The first man *is* of the earth, earthy; the second man *is* the Master from heaven.

48 As *is* the earthy, such *are* they also that are earthy: and as *is* the heavenly, such *are* they also that are heavenly.


49 And as we have borne the
image of the earthy, we shall
also bear the image of the
heavenly.

50 Now this I say, brethren, that
flesh and blood cannot inherit
the kingdom of Yahweh; neither
doth corruption inherit
incorruption.



51 Behold, I shew you a mystery;
We shall not all sleep, but we
shall all be changed,

52 In a moment, in the
twinkling of an eye, at the last
trump: for the trumpet shall
sound, and the dead shall be
raised incorruptible, and we
shall be changed.



53 For this corruptible *must* put
on incorruption, and this mortal
must put on immortality.

54 So when this corruptible
shall have put on incorruption,
and this mortal shall have put
on immortality, then shall be
brought to pass the saying that
is written, Death is swallowed
up in victory.

55 O death, where *is* thy
sting? O grave, where *is* thy
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56 The sting of death *is* sin;
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57 But thanks *be* to Elohim,
which giveth us the victory
through our Master Yahshua
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
58 Therefore, my beloved
brethren, be ye stedfast,
unmoveable, always abounding in
the work of Yahweh, forasmuch
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John 20:15-17

She turned herself, and saith unto
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

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24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Yahshua came.

25 The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Master. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in his hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into his side, I will not believe.



26 And after eight days again his disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Yahshua, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, Peace be unto you.

27 Then saith he to Thomas, Reach hither thy finger, and behold my hands; and reach hither thy hand, and thrust it into my side: and be not faithless, but believing.

Yahshua fulfilled the feast of
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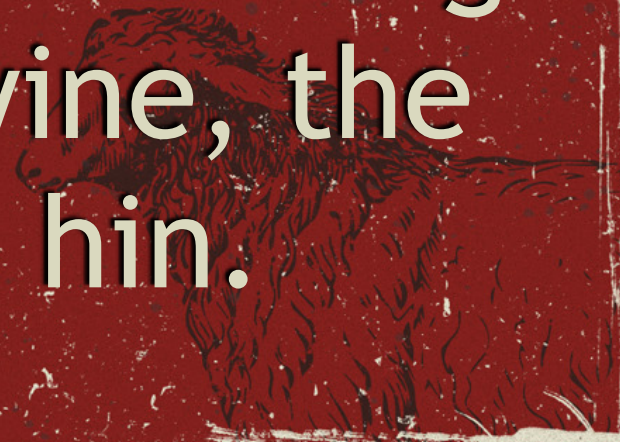
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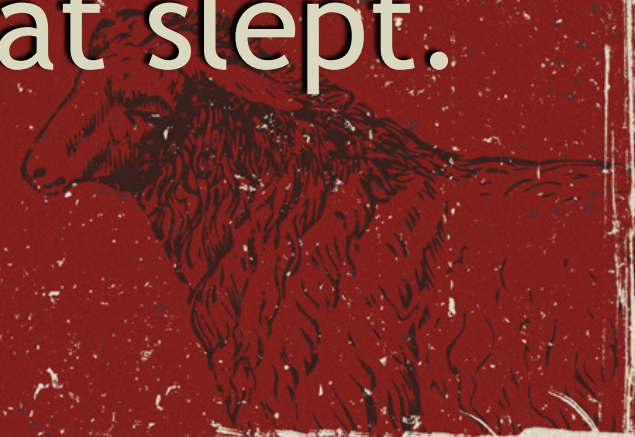
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
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
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
