Luke 4:43 And he said unto them, I must preach the kingdom of Yahweh to other cities also: for therefore am I sent.

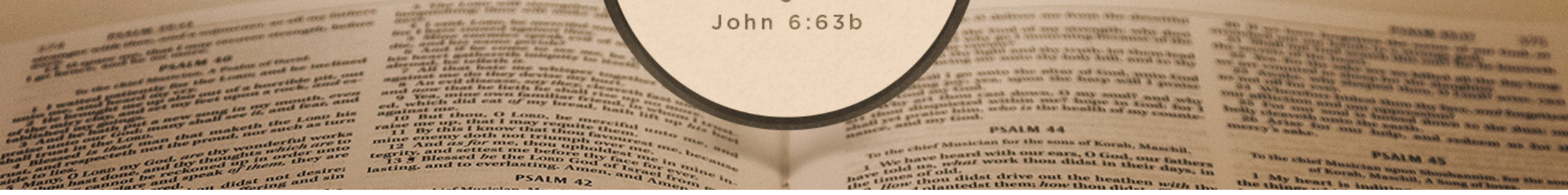
This same

2 Corinthians 4:1-4

1 Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not;

2 But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of Elohim deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of Elohim

3 But if our good news be hid, it is hid to them that are lost:

4 In whom the mighty one of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious good news of Messiah, who is the image of Elohim, should shine unto them.

2 Corinthians 11:1-4

Paul covered A-Z of the Christian Faith.

If you accept;
A different Yeshua
A different Spirit
A different Gospel

If you deviate from it
You will reap what you sow.

If Messiah IS the gospel, then why are “another *Yahshua*” and “another *gospel*” listed as *two* separate problems?

People need to wake up to the deception –the mass delusion–of a supposed Christianity that denies virtually all the plain truths of the Bible! Yahweh’s plan for mankind is staggering–incomparable to anything human beings have devised to replace what He says.

The world ignores plain, clear, unmistakable scriptures found throughout the Bible about the Kingdom of Yahweh.

Luke 6:26 Woe unto you, when all men shall speak well of you! for so did their fathers to the false prophets.

They want to be spoken well of.

They want to be respected.

They want to be loved and lifted up.

They want to be followed!!!

I wrote unto the assembly: but
Diotrephes, who loveth to have
the preeminence among them,

2 Corinthians 11:10-15

10 As the truth of Messiah is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia.

11 Wherefore? because I love you not? Elohim knoweth.

12 But what I do, that I will do, that I may cut off occasion from them which desire occasion; that wherein they glory, they may be found even as we.

13 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Messiah.

14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

This is a blunt, shocking
scripture. Yet it is true
that Satan has ministers
who *appear* to be the
ministers of Elohim.
