Job 33

4 The Spirit of El hath made me, and the breath of the Almighty hath given me life.

5 If thou canst answer me, set *thy words* in order before me, stand up.

6 Behold, I *am* according to thy wish in El's stead: I also am formed out of the clay.

**Elohim took clay and His own
breath, and brought all of His
genius to the matter and spirit

**Anything that is composed has
to have been composed by
someone, and the COMPOSER is
GREATER than the
COMPOSITION.**

This means Elohim can do what he wants. It means he is not subject to physical limitations like man is. Being omnipotent, Elohim has power over wind, water, gravity, physics, etc.

Psalms 89:1-9

**1 I will sing of the mercies of
Yahweh for ever: with my mouth
will I make known thy faithfulness
to all generations.**

**2 For I have said, Mercy shall be
built up for ever: thy faithfulness
shalt thou establish in the very
heavens.**

3 I have made a covenant with my
chosen, I have sworn unto David my
servant,

4 Thy seed will I establish for ever,
and build up thy throne to all
generations. Selah.

5 And the heavens shall praise thy
wonders, O Yahweh: thy faithfulness
also in the congregation of the saints.

6 For who in the heaven can be compared unto Yahweh? *who* among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto Yahweh?

7 El is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all *them that* are about him.

Omniscience all-knowing, the state of knowing everything.

Jeremiah 32:17-19

17 Ah my Sovereign Yahweh! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, *and* there is nothing too hard for thee:

18 Thou shewest lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompensest the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty El, Yahweh of hosts, *is* his name,

19 Great in counsel, and mighty in
work: for thine eyes are open
upon all the ways of the sons of
men: to give every one according
to his ways, and according to the
fruit of his doings:

ISAIAH 44:7 (NASB)

Elohim is all-knowing in the sense that he is aware of the past, present, and future. Nothing takes him by surprise. His knowledge is total. He knows all that can be known.

For his eyes *are* upon the ways of man, and he seeth all his goings.

Psalms 139:1-24

1 O Yahweh, thou hast searched me,
and known *me*.

2 Thou knowest my downsitting and
mine uprising, thou understandest my
thought afar off.

3 Thou compassest my path and my
lying down, and art acquainted *with* all
my ways.

4 For *there is* not a word in my tongue,
but, lo, O Yahweh, thou knowest it
altogether.

5 Thou hast beset me behind and
before, and laid thine hand upon me.

6 *Such* knowledge *is* too wonderful for
me; it is high, I cannot *attain* unto it.

7 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or
whither shall I flee from thy presence?

8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou *art*
there: if I make my bed in the grave,
behold, thou *art there*.

9 *If* I take the wings of the morning,
and dwell in the uttermost parts of the
sea;

10 Even there shall thy hand lead me,
and thy right hand shall hold me.

11 If I say, Surely the darkness shall
cover me; even the night shall be light
about me.

12 Yea, the darkness hideth not from
thee; but the night shineth as the day:
the darkness and the light *are* both
alike *to thee*.

13 For thou hast possessed my reins:
thou hast covered me in my mother's
womb.

14 I will praise thee; for I am fearfully
and wonderfully made: marvellous *are*
thy works; and *that* my soul knoweth
right well.

15 My substance was not hid from
thee, when I was made in secret, *and*
curiously wrought in the lowest parts of
the earth.

16 Thine eyes did see my substance, yet
being unperfect; and in thy book all *my*
members were written, *which* in continuance
were fashioned, when *as yet there was*
none of them.

17 How precious also are thy thoughts unto
me, O El! how great is the sum of them!

18 *If* I should count them, they are more in
number than the sand: when I awake, I am
still with thee.

19 Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O
Eloah: depart from me therefore, ye
bloody men.

20 For they speak against thee
wickedly, *and* thine enemies take *thy*
name in vain.

21 Do not I hate them, O Yahweh, that
hate thee? and am not I grieved with
those that rise up against thee?

22 I hate them with perfect hatred: I
count them mine enemies.

23 Search me, O El, and know my
heart: try me, and know my
thoughts:

24 And see if *there be any* wicked
way in me, and lead me in the way
everlasting.

**There is nothing that is outside the
scope of His conception,
understanding, or attention.**

There is one reality and Elohim knows it in its entirety, as it exists by, through, and for Him. Elohim is neither surprised by the way the world works itself out, nor shocked by the choices we make.

Omnipresence all-present.

**No one can hide from Elohim
He is everywhere, close to
everything, next to everyone.**

Jeremiah 23:23-24

23 *Am* I an Elohim at hand, saith Yahweh, and not an Elohim afar off?

24 Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith Yahweh. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith Yahweh.

Isaiah 43:1-2

1 But now thus saith Yahweh that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called *thee* by thy name; thou *art* mine.

2 When thou passest through the waters, I *will be* with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee.
