

Antichrist-Beast is the son of Satan and both have the same proud character. They both have 'I' problems - 'I' is the middle letter in pride and the middle letter in sin.

We have to know how to be poor in spirit

Satan will have a son ought not to surprise us. The Devil is a consummate imitator and much of his success in deceiving men is due to his marvelous skill in counterfeiting the things of God.

...and the wicked shall be destroyed.
...but the salvation of the righteous is of the Lord.
...and the Lord shall help them, and deliver them, because they trust in him.

We read of Christ going forth to sow the "good seed" (Matt. 13:24), then we also read of the enemy going forth to sow his "tares" -- an imitation wheat (Matt. 13:25).

Matthew 13:24-25

24 Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field:

25 But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way.

**We read of "the children of God,"
then we also read of "the children
of the wicked one" (Matt. 13:36-43)**

Matthew 13:36-43

36 Then Yahshua sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field.

37 He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man;

38 The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one;

39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

40 As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world.

41 The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;

42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

43 Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. Who hath ears to hear, let him hear.

We read of God working in His children "both to will and to do of His good pleasure" (Phil.2:13-16), then we are also told that the Prince of the power of the air is "the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience" (Eph.2:2).

Philippians 2:13-16

13 For it is Elohim which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

14 Do all things without murmurings and disputings:

**15 That ye may be blameless and
harmless, the sons of Elohim,
without rebuke, in the midst of a
crooked and perverse nation, among
whom ye shine as lights in the world;
16 Holding forth the word of life; that
I may rejoice in the day of Messiah,
that I have not run in vain, neither
laboured in vain.**

Ephesians 2:2

**Wherein in time past ye walked
according to the course of this
world, according to the prince of the
power of the air, the spirit that now
worketh in the children of
disobedience:**

**We read of the Gospel of God,
then we also read that Satan has a
gospel -- "Another gospel, which is
not another" (Gal. 1:6, 7).**

Galatians 1:1-9

1 Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Yahshua Messiah, and Yahweh the Father, who raised him from the dead;)

2 And all the brethren which are with me, unto the assemblies of Galatia:

**3 Grace be to you and peace from
Yahweh the Father, and from our
Master Yahshua Messiah,**

**4 Who gave himself for our sins, that
he might deliver us from this present
evil world, according to the will of El
and our Father:**

**5 To whom be glory for ever and
ever. Amen.**

**6 I marvel that ye are so soon
removed from him that called you
into the grace of Messiah unto
another good news:**

7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the good news of Messiah.

8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other good news unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other good news unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Christ appoint "apostles," then Satan has his apostles too (2 Cor. 11:13-15; Matthew 7:15, 2 Peter 2:1,).

2 Corinthians 11:13-15

**13 For such are false apostles,
deceitful workers, transforming
themselves into the apostles of
Messiah.**

**14 And no marvel; for Satan himself
is transformed into an angel of light.**

**15 Therefore it is no great thing if
his ministers also be transformed as
the ministers of righteousness;
whose end shall be according to
their works.**

Matthew 7:15

Beware of false prophets, which come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravening wolves.

2 Peter 2:1

But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

**The Father seek
"worshippers" (John 4:23-24),
so also does Satan (Rev. 13:4).**

John 4:23-24

23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him.

24 Yahweh is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Revelation 13:4

**And they worshipped the dragon
which gave power unto the beast:
and they worshipped the beast,
saying, Who is like unto the beast?
who is able to make war with him?**

**Christ quote scripture, so also
did Satan (Matt.4:1-6).**

Matthew 4:1-6

1 Then was Yahshua led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

2 And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred.

3 And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of Yahweh, command that these stones be made bread.

4 But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of Yahweh. (Deut. 8:3)

**5 Then the devil taketh him up into the
holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle
of the temple,**

**6 And saith unto him, If thou be the Son
of Yahweh, cast thyself down: for it is
written, He shall give his angels charge
concerning thee: and in their hands
they shall bear thee up, lest at any time
thou dash thy foot against a stone.**

(psalms 91:11-12)

**Christ is the Light of the world
(John 8:12), then Satan also is
transformed as an "angel of light"
(2 Cor. 11:14).**

John 8:12

Then spake Yahshua again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.

2 Corinthians 11:14

And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.

Christ is denominated "the Lion of the tribe of Judah" (Rev.5:5), then the Devil is also referred to as "a roaring lion" (1 Peter 5:8).

Revelation 5:5

**And one of the elders saith unto me,
Weep not: behold the Lion of the
tribe of Juda, the Root of David,
hath prevailed to open the book, and
to loose the seven seals thereof.**

1 Peter 5:8

**Be sober, be vigilant; because your
adversary the devil, as a roaring
lion, walketh about, seeking whom
he may devour.**

We read of Christ and "His angels" (Matt. 24:30-31), then we also read of the Devil and "his angels" (Revelation 12:9; Matt. 25:41).

Matthew 24:30-31

30 And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Revelation 12:9

**And the great dragon was cast out,
that old serpent, called the Devil,
and Satan, which deceiveth the
whole world: he was cast out into
the earth, and his angels were cast
out with him.**

Matthew 25:41

Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:

Christ work miracles(changed water into wine John 2:1-11; cured the nobleman's son John 4:46-47; the great haul of fishes Luke 5:1-11; cast out an unclean spirit Mark 1:23-28; cured Peter's mother-in-law of a fever Mark 1:30-31; healed a leper Mark 1:40-45), so also will the son of satan (2 Thess.2:9-10).

2 Thessalonians 2:9-10

9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders,

10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

It is written of Satan -

**“I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I
will be like the most High” -
(Is. 14:14).**

Antichrist-Beast will accept from Satan what the Lord Jesus rejected - “And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, showed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it. If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine” - (Luke 4:5-7).

Ezekiel 28:12-19

Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith my Sovereign Yahweh; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.

13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of Elohim; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created.

14 Thou *art* the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of Elohim; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.

15 Thou *wast* perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of Elohim: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.

**17 Thine heart was lifted up because
of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted
thy wisdom by reason of thy
brightness: I will cast thee to the
ground, I will lay thee before kings,
that they may behold thee.**

**18 Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries
by the multitude of thine iniquities,
by the iniquity of thy traffick;
therefore will I bring forth a fire
from the midst of thee, it shall
devour thee, and I will bring thee to
ashes upon the earth in the sight of
all them that behold thee.**

**19 All they that know thee among
the people shall be astonished at
thee: thou shalt be a terror, and
never *shalt* thou *be* any more.**

Revelation 20:10-11

10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Job 42

1 Then Job answered Yahweh, and said,

2 I know that thou canst do every *thing*, and *that* no thought can be withholden from thee.

3 Who *is* he that hideth counsel without knowledge? therefore have I uttered that I understood not; things too wonderful for me, which I knew not.

4 Hear, I beseech thee, and I will speak: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me.

5 I have heard of thee by the hearing of the ear: but now mine eye seeth thee.

6 Wherefore I abhor *myself*, and repent in dust and ashes.

7 And it was so, that after Yahweh had spoken these words unto Job, Yahweh said to Eliphaz the Temanite, My wrath is kindled against thee, and against thy two friends: for ye have not spoken of me *the thing that is right*, as my servant Job *hath*.

8 Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to my servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and my servant Job shall pray for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you *after your* folly, in that ye have not spoken of me *the thing which is* right, like my servant Job.

**9 So Eliphaz the Temanite and Bildad the Shuhite *and* Zophar the Naamathite went, and did according as Yahweh commanded them:
Yahweh also accepted Job.**

10 And Yahweh turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also Yahweh gave Job twice as much as he had before.

11 Then came there unto him all his brethren, and all his sisters, and all they that had been of his acquaintance before, and did eat bread with him in his house: and they bemoaned him, and comforted him over all the evil that Yahweh had brought upon him: every man also gave him a piece of money, and every one an earring of gold.

12 So Yahweh blessed the latter end of Job more than his beginning: for he had fourteen thousand sheep, and six thousand camels, and a thousand yoke of oxen, and a thousand she donkeys.

13 He had also seven sons and three daughters.

14 And he called the name of the first, Jemima; and the name of the second, Kezia; and the name of the third, Kerenhappuch.

15 And in all the land were no women found so fair as the daughters of Job: and their father gave them inheritance among their brethren.

16 After this lived Job an hundred and forty years, and saw his sons, and his sons' sons, *even* four generations.

17 So Job died, *being* old and full of days.

Luke 17:5-10

5 And the apostles said unto the Master, Increase our faith.

6 And the Master said, If ye had faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye might say unto this sycamine tree, Be thou plucked up by the root, and be thou planted in the sea; and it should obey you.

7 But which of you, having a servant plowing or feeding cattle, will say unto him by and by, when he is come from the field, Go and sit down to meat?

8 And will not rather say unto him, Make ready wherewith I may sup, and gird thyself, and serve me, till I have eaten and drunken; and afterward thou shalt eat and drink?

**9 Doth he thank that servant
because he did the things that were
commanded him? I trow not.**

**10 So likewise ye, when ye shall
have done all those things which are
commanded you, say, We are
unprofitable servants : we have done
that which was our duty to do.**
