**A believer is justified by faith because faith unites a person to Yahshua Messiah, who justifies, sanctifies and glorifies believers through the power of His shed blood. This power is applied to the life of the believer by the presence and power of the Holy Spirit.**

# The Trivialization of What is Called “Christianity” In Our Time

Faith, which unites a person to  
Messiah, has been reduced to belief,  
an assent to certain truths

**Simply believing certain things will  
never change your life, as if  
believing what the devil, himself,  
knows to be true would change you.  
No, Yahshua Messiah changes you!**

Faith is the bond of a living union with Messiah. And when Messiah enters a life, He comes to forgive you *and* to make you holy. He accepts you as you are, but His grace will never leave you as you are.

The replacement of faith, which unites a person to Messiah, with mere assent to certain truths, leads thousands of people to “accept Messiah” without ever bowing to His Lordship in their lives. We end up with a form of faith that does not change our lives. The world despises this, and it is right to do so.

## Isaiah 55

as a good soldier of Yahshua  
Messiah.**

**4 No man that warreth entangleth  
himself with the affairs of this life;  
that he may please him who hath  
chosen him to be a soldier.**

**5 And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully.**

**6 The husbandman that laboureth must be first partaker of the fruits.**

**7 Consider what I say; and the Master give thee understanding in all things.**

**8 Remember that Yahshua Messiah  
of the seed of David was raised from  
the dead according to my good  
news:**

**9 Wherein I suffer trouble, as an  
evil doer, even unto bonds; but the  
word of Elohim is not bound.**

**10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Messiah Yahshua with eternal glory.**

**11 It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him:**

**12 If we suffer, we shall also reign  
with him: if we deny him, he also  
will deny us:**

**13 If we believe not, yet he abideth  
faithful: he cannot deny himself.**

**14 Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them before the Master that they strive not about words to no profit, but to the subverting of the hearers.**

**15 Study to shew thyself approved unto Elohim, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.**



**16 But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more wickedness.**

**17 And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus;**

**18 Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some.**

**19 Nevertheless the foundation of Elohim standeth sure, having this seal, The Master knoweth them that are his. And, let every one that nameth the name of Messiah depart from iniquity.**

**20 But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.**

**21 If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work.**

**22 Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Master out of a pure heart.**

**23 But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes.**

**24 And the servant of the Master must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient,**

**25 In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if Elohim peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;**

**26 And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.**
