**The emptiness that fills our lives,  
can only be satisfied in Messiah, the  
true Righteousness. Only by  
hungering and thirsting after Messiah  
can that void, that emptiness, be  
filled**



**The things of this world will not satisfy; only Yahshua Messiah satisfies. So why keep “messaging around” with things that will only cause more pain and emptiness? An offer of joy, peace, and satisfaction among many other things is made to you in Messiah - and in Messiah alone.**

**To be hungry is not enough; I must  
be really starving to know what is in  
His heart towards me. When the  
prodigal son was hungry he went to  
feed upon husks, but when he was  
starving, he turned to his father**

*...gressors shall be peace.  
...and the salvation of the wicked shall be destroyed.  
...their strength in the time of trouble.  
...And the Lord shall help them, and deliver them,  
because they trust in him.*



## **Luke 15:11-24**

**11 And he said, A certain man had two sons:**

**12 And the younger of them said to his father, Father, give me the portion of goods that falleth to me. And he divided unto them his living.**



**13 And not many days after the younger son gathered all together, and took his journey into a far country, and there wasted his substance with riotous living.**

**14 And when he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want.**



**15 And he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country; and he sent him into his fields to feed swine.**

**16 And he would fain have filled his belly with the husks that the swine did eat: and no man gave unto him.**



**17 And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!**

**18 I will arise and go to my father, and will say unto him, Father, I have sinned against heaven, and before thee,**



**19 And am no more worthy to be called thy son: make me as one of thy hired servants.**

**20 And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had compassion, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him.**



**21 And the son said unto him,  
Father, I have sinned against heaven,  
and in thy sight, and am no more  
worthy to be called thy son.**

**22 But the father said to his  
servants, Bring forth the best robe,  
and put it on him; and put a ring on  
his hand, and shoes on his feet:**



**23 And bring hither the fatted calf,  
and kill it; and let us eat, and be  
merry.**

**24 For this my son was dead, and is  
alive again; he was lost, and is  
found. And they began to be merry.**



**We as human beings are far too easily pleased. We fool around with so many things that do not satisfy, things that do not, and cannot, fill that void and emptiness, all because we are far too easily pleased**

...And the Lord shall help them, and del

**We think so often that the things of  
this world will satisfy, when we  
always end up falling short of what  
we desire, and a lot of it is because  
we are not seeking the right things.  
(Matthew 6:33)**



**The joy that is offered to us, the peace that is offered to us, the satisfaction that is offered to us, is unbelievable if we would only grab hold of Yahshua and His offer to be our satisfaction.**

**(John 14:27; Matthew 11:28-30)**

## John 14:27

Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.



## **Matthew 11:28-30**

**28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.**

**29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls.**

**30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.**



**Yahshua is the only way to

**The woman at the well (John 4:7-14)  
Feeding the 5000 ( John 6:26-35)**



## **John 4:7-14**

**7 There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Yahshua saith unto her, Give me to drink.**

**8 (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.)**



**9 Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.**



**10 Yahshua answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of Elohim, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.**



**11 The woman saith unto him, Sir,  
thou hast nothing to draw with, and  
the well is deep: from whence then  
hast thou that living water?**

**12 Art thou greater than our father  
Jacob, which gave us the well, and  
drank thereof himself, and his  
children, and his cattle?**



**13 Yahshua answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:**

**14 But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.**



## **John 6:26-35**

**26 Yahshua answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.**



**27 Labour not for the meat which  
perisheth, but for that meat which  
endureth unto everlasting life, which  
the Son of man shall give unto you:  
for him hath Yahweh the Father  
sealed.**



**28 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of Elohim?**

**29 Yahshua answered and said unto them, This is the work of Elohim, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.**



**30 They said therefore unto him,  
What sign shewest thou then, that  
we may see, and believe thee? what  
dost thou work?**

**31 Our fathers did eat manna in the  
desert; as it is written, He gave them  
bread from heaven to eat.**



**32 Then Yahshua said unto them,  
Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses  
gave you not that bread from  
heaven; but my Father giveth you  
the true bread from heaven.**

**33 For the bread of Elohim is he  
which cometh down from heaven,  
and giveth life unto the world.**



**34 Then said they unto him, Master,  
evermore give us this bread.**

**35 And Yahshua said unto them, I am  
the bread of life: he that cometh to  
me shall never hunger; and he that  
believeth on me shall never thirst.**



**I truly believe there is a big,  
important message to us as  
believers. In our life right now, what  
are we hungering and thirsting after?  
Where is our heart?**



**It is easy for us as believers to see that we are filled and satisfied when we accept the free gift of salvation, but too often that is where hungering and thirsting stops.**

*...the end of that man is peace, and behold  
the end of the wicked shall be destroyed.  
And the Lord shall help them, and deliver them,  
because they trust in him.*



**Many believers struggle with big areas of sin, and they try to fill a hole with something other than Yahshua Messiah; many families have been destroyed through not hungering and thirsting after righteousness only to end up in divorce.**



**The mark of a true christian is that he never feels he has arrived at a righteous life. What does he do? He must hunger and thirst for righteousness.**



**Some of us sit week after week in the pews at church longing for a day in and day out satisfaction. Do we as believers hunger and thirst after righteousness?**



**Hunger and thirst is continual. We need to hunger and thirst, actually starve, for righteousness in our lives; it is a day-by-day thing that is a continual part of our lives.**



# Psalms 145

And the Lord shall help them, and deliver them, because they trust in him.



**With righteousness, once we get a taste of it and hunger for it, that hunger for righteousness grows, and we should want to keep feeding that desire to satisfy our lives with righteousness.**



**We need to hunger after Elohim on a daily basis, every second of every day. Hungering and thirsting need to be vital parts of our lives, such that we cannot live without satisfying that hunger and thirst.**



## **Psalms 130: 5-6**

**5 I wait for Yahweh, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.**

**6 My soul *waiteth* for Yahweh more than they that watch for the morning: *I say, more than* they that watch for the morning.**



**If you have any hunger for righteousness at all, it is Messiah who is provoking this, who is awakening this in you. He does not do this to mock you. He does this so that you will receive. He creates a hunger, a thirst for righteousness in you, so that you may be satisfied for all eternity.**



## **1 Corinthians 1:30**

**But of him are ye in Messiah  
Yahshua, who of Elohim is made unto  
us wisdom, and righteousness, and  
sanctification, and redemption:**
