Yahshua's Announcement of a Coming Crisis

In the light of this background information, Jesus' public proclamation of the nearness of the Kingdom of God must be understood as a warning about a great future crisis in history. The stupendous event foreseen not only by Daniel, but by the other Hebrew prophets, demanded an immediate repentance and reformation of lifestyle a, because they trust in h:

The point of the call for repentance, "for the Kingdom of Elohim is at hand" (Mark 1:14-15), was simply that a place in the Kingdom would be granted only to those found living in faithful obedience to Elohim.
