## **Psalms 34:1-19**

**1 I will bless Yahweh at all times: his praise *shall* continually *be* in my mouth.**

**2 My soul shall make her boast in Yahweh: the humble shall hear *thereof*, and be glad.**

**3 O magnify Yahweh with me, and let us exalt his name together.**

4 I sought Yahweh, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

5 They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed.

6 This poor man cried, and Yahweh heard *him*, and saved him out of all his troubles.



**7 The angel of Yahweh encampeth  
round about them that fear him,  
and delivereth them.**

**8 O taste and see that Yahweh *is*  
good: blessed *is* the man *that*  
trusteth in him.**

**9 O fear Yahweh, ye his saints: for  
*there is* no want to them that fear  
him.**

10 The young lions do lack, and  
suffer hunger: but they that seek  
Yahweh shall not want any good  
*thing.*

11 Come, ye children, hearken unto  
me: I will teach you the fear of  
Yahweh.

12 What man *is he that* desireth life,  
*and loveth many* days, that he may  
see good?

**13 Keep thy tongue from evil, and  
thy lips from speaking guile.**

**14 Depart from evil, and do good;  
seek peace, and pursue it.**

**15 The eyes of Yahweh *are* upon the  
righteous, and his ears *are open*  
unto their cry.**



**16 The face of Yahweh *is* against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.**

**17 *The righteous* cry, and Yahweh heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles.**

**18 Yahweh *is* nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit.**

**19 Many are the afflictions of the  
righteous: but Yahweh delivereth  
him out of them all.**

## Isaiah 57:15

For thus saith the high and lofty  
One that inhabiteth eternity, whose  
name *is* Holy; I dwell in the high and  
holy *place*, with him also *that is* of a  
contrite and humble spirit, to revive  
the spirit of the humble, and to  
revive the heart of the contrite  
ones.



If we as a person have not  
become more heavenly, if our  
home is not more heavenly, if  
our church is not more  
heavenly, our community more  
heavenly, we have not learned  
how to be poor in spirit.

Poor in spirit is like a beggar  
who is always in need of  
Yahweh's help.

## **Genesis 2:7-9**

**7 And Yahweh Elohim formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul.**

**8 And Yahweh Elohim planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.**



**9 And out of the ground made  
Yahweh Elohim to grow every tree  
that is pleasant to the sight, and  
good for food; the tree of life also in  
the midst of the garden, and the  
tree of knowledge of good and evil.**

## Genesis 2:15-17

**15 And Yahweh Elohim took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.**

**16 And Yahweh Elohim commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:**

**17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.**



## **Genesis 3:1-11**

**1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which Yahweh Elohim had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath Elohim said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?**

**2 And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden:**

**3 But of the fruit of the tree which *is* in the midst of the garden, Elohim hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.**

**4 And the serpent said unto the woman, **Ye shall not surely die:****

**5 For Elohim doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, **then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as mighty ones, knowing good and evil.****

6 And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.



**7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.**

**8 And they heard the voice of  
Yahweh Elohim walking in the  
garden in the cool of the day: and  
Adam and his wife hid themselves  
from the presence of Yahweh Elohim  
amongst the trees of the garden.**

**9 And Yahweh Elohim called unto  
Adam, and said unto him, Where *art*  
thou?**

**10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I *was* naked; and I hid myself.**

**11 And he said, Who told thee that thou *wast* naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?**



## Genesis 3:22

And Yahweh Elohim said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:

Being poor in spirit is a life of perpetual dependence on Yahweh. We cannot and will not do anything with out Yahweh's help.

A person who is poor in spirit is  
totally dependent on Yahweh  
through prayer.



**Luke 18:1**

**And he spake a parable unto them  
to this end, that men ought always  
to pray, and not to faint;**

**1 Thessalonians 5:17**

**Pray without ceasing.**

## Matthew 6:5-6

**5 And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.**

**6 But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.**



A person who is poor in spirit  
will pray always.

**Luke 18:1**

And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought **always** to pray, and not to faint;

**Philippians 4:4**

Rejoice in Yahweh **always**: and again I say, Rejoice.

**2 Corinthians 4:10**

**Always** bearing about in the body the dying of the Master Yahshua, that the life also of Yahshua might be made manifest in our body.

# 1 Corinthians 4:1-7

- 1 Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Messiah, and stewards of the mysteries of Elohim.
- 2 Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found faithful.
- 3 But with me it is a very small thing that I should be judged of you, or of man's judgment: yea, I judge not mine own self.



**4 For I know nothing by myself; yet  
am I not hereby justified: but he that  
judgeth me is Yahweh.**

**5 Therefore judge nothing before the  
time, until Master come, who both  
will bring to light the hidden things  
of darkness, and will make manifest  
the counsels of the hearts: and then  
shall every man have praise of  
Elohim.**

**6 And these things, brethren, I have in a figure transferred to myself and to Apollos for your sakes; that ye might learn in us not to think of men above that which is written, that no one of you be puffed up for one against another.**

7 For who maketh thee to differ from another? and what hast thou that thou didst not receive? now if thou didst receive it, why dost thou glory, as if thou hadst not received it?

## Proverbs 8:33-36

**33 Hear instruction, and be wise,  
and refuse it not.**

**34 Blessed *is* the man that heareth  
me, watching daily at my gates,  
waiting at the posts of my doors.**

**35 For whoso findeth me findeth  
life, and shall obtain favour of  
Yahweh.**

**36 But he that sinneth against me  
wrongeth his own soul: all they that  
hate me love death.**

## **Matthew 7:21-24**

**21 Not every one that saith unto me, Master, Master, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.**

**22 Many will say to me in that day, Master, Master, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works?**



**23 And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.**

**24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:**

It is your birthright to possess  
more of the Kingdom of heaven  
in your life and to be at peace  
in your life.

Poor in spirit means I am aware  
of my own needs and my own  
relationship with Yahweh.



Being poor in spirit leads to  
mourning, mourning leads to  
meekness, meekness leads to  
righteousness

## **1 Peter 3:1-4**

**1 Likewise, ye wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;**  
**2 While they behold your chaste conversation coupled with fear.**

**3 Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel;**

**4 But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of Elohim of great price.**



A meek and quiet spirit,  
not complaining, fighting and  
arguing.
