# The Book Of Job

## Understanding the WORDS of JESUS

John 6:63b

## **Job 1:1-22**

**1 There was a man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job; and that man was perfect and upright, and one that feared Elohim, and eschewed evil.**

**2 And there were born unto him seven sons and three daughters.**



**3 His substance also was seven thousand sheep, and three thousand camels, and five hundred yoke of oxen, and five hundred she donkeys, and a very great household; so that this man was the greatest of all the men of the east.**

**4 And his sons went and feasted *in their* houses, every one his day; and sent and called for their three sisters to eat and to drink with them.**

5 And it was so, when the days of *their* feasting were gone about, that Job sent and sanctified them, and rose up early in the morning, and offered burnt offerings *according* to the number of them all: for Job said, It may be that my sons have sinned, and cursed Elohim in their hearts. Thus did Job continually.

**6 Now there was a day when the sons of Elohim came to present themselves before Yahweh, and Satan came also among them.**

**7 And Yahweh said unto Satan, Whence comest thou? Then Satan answered Yahweh, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.**



**8 And Yahweh said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth Elohim, and escheweth evil?**

**9 Then Satan answered Yahweh, and said, Doth Job fear Elohim for nought?**

**10 Hast not thou made an hedge  
about him, and about his house, and  
about all that he hath on every side?  
thou hast blessed the work of his  
hands, and his substance is  
increased in the land.**

**11 But put forth thine hand now,  
and touch all that he hath, and he  
will curse thee to thy face.**



**12 And Yahweh said unto Satan,  
Behold, all that he hath *is* in thy  
power; only upon himself put not  
forth thine hand. So Satan went  
forth from the presence of Yahweh.**

**13 And there was a day when his  
sons and his daughters *were* eating  
and drinking wine in their eldest  
brother's house:**

**15 And the Sabeans fell *upon them*,

**16 While he was yet speaking, there came also another, and said, The fire of Elohim is fallen from heaven, and hath burned up the sheep, and the servants, and consumed them; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.**



**17 While he was yet speaking, there came also another, and said, The Chaldeans made out three bands, and fell upon the camels, and have carried them away, yea, and slain the servants with the edge of the sword; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.**

**18 While he *was* yet speaking, there came also another, and said, Thy sons and thy daughters *were* eating and drinking wine in their eldest brother's house:**

**19 And, behold, there came a great wind from the wilderness, and smote the four corners of the house, and it fell upon the young men, and they are dead; and I only am escaped alone to tell thee.**

**20 Then Job arose, and rent his  
mantle, and shaved his head, and  
fell down upon the ground, and  
worshipped,**

**21 And said, Naked came I out of my  
mother's womb, and naked shall I  
return thither: Yahweh gave, and  
Yahweh hath taken away; blessed be  
the name of Yahweh.**



**22 In all this Job sinned not, nor charged Elohim foolishly.**

## **Job 2:1-13**

**1 Again there was a day when the sons of Elohim came to present themselves before Yahweh, and Satan came also among them to present himself before Yahweh.**

**2 And Yahweh said unto Satan, From whence comest thou? And Satan answered Yahweh, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.**

**3 And Yahweh said unto Satan, Hast thou considered my servant Job, that *there is* none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that feareth Elohim, and escheweth evil? and still he holdeth fast his integrity, although thou movedst me against him, to destroy him without cause.**



4 And Satan answered Yahweh, and said, Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will he give for his life.

5 But put forth thine hand now, and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will curse thee to thy face.

6 And Yahweh said unto Satan, Behold, he *is* in thine hand; but save his life.

**7 So went Satan forth from the presence of Yahweh, and smote Job with sore boils from the sole of his foot unto his crown.**

**8 And he took him a potsherd to scrape himself withal; and he sat down among the ashes.**

**9 Then said his wife unto him, Dost thou still retain thine integrity? curse Elohim, and die.**

**10 But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of Elohim, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.**



**11 Now when Job's three friends heard of all this evil that was come upon him, they came every one from his own place; Eliphaz the Temanite, and Bildad the Shuhite, and Zophar the Naamathite: for they had made an appointment together to come to mourn with him and to comfort him.**

12 And when they lifted up their eyes afar off, and knew him not, they lifted up their voice, and wept; and they rent every one his mantle, and sprinkled dust upon their heads toward heaven.

13 So they sat down with him upon the ground seven days and seven nights, and none spake a word unto him: for they saw that *his* grief was very great.

**13 For now should I have lain still  
and been quiet, I should have slept:  
then had I been at rest,  
14 With kings and counsellors of the  
earth, which built desolate places  
for themselves;  
15 Or with princes that had gold,  
who filled their houses with silver:**



**16 Or as an hidden untimely birth I  
had not been; as infants *which*  
never saw light.**

**17 There the wicked cease *from*  
troubling; and there the weary be at  
rest.**

**18 *There* the prisoners rest  
together; they hear not the voice of  
the oppressor.**

**19 The small and great are there;  
and the servant *is* free from his  
master.**

**20 Wherefore is light given to him  
that is in misery, and life unto the  
bitter *in* soul;**

**21 Which long for death, but it  
*cometh* not; and dig for it more than  
for hid treasures;**

**22 Which rejoice exceedingly, *and*  
are glad, when they can find the  
grave?**

**23 *Why is light given* to a man  
whose way is hid, and whom Eloah  
hath hedged in?**

**24 For my sighing cometh before I  
eat, and my roarings are poured out  
like the waters.**

## Job 29

1 Moreover Job continued his parable, and said,

2 Oh that I were as *in* months past,  
as *in* the days *when* Eloah preserved  
me;

3 When his candle shined upon my  
head, *and when* by his light I walked  
*through* darkness;



**4 As I was in the days of my youth,  
when the secret of Eloah was upon  
my tabernacle;**

**5 When the Almighty was yet with  
me, *when* my children were about  
me;**

**6 When I washed my steps with  
butter, and the rock poured me out  
rivers of oil;**

**7 When I went out to the gate  
through the city, *when* I prepared  
my seat in the street!**

**8 The young men saw me, and hid  
themselves: and the aged arose, *and*  
stood up.**

**9 The princes refrained talking, and  
laid *their* hand on their mouth.**

10 The nobles held their peace, and  
their tongue cleaved to the roof of  
their mouth.

11 When the ear heard *me*, then it  
blessed me; and when the eye saw  
*me*, it gave witness to me:

12 Because I delivered the poor that  
cried, and the fatherless, and *him*  
*that had* none to help him.



**13 The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy.**

**14 I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment was as a robe and a diadem.**

**15 I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame.**

16 I *was* a father to the poor: and  
the cause *which* I knew not I  
searched out.

17 And I brake the jaws of the  
wicked, and plucked the spoil out of  
his teeth.

18 Then I said, I shall die in my nest,  
and I shall multiply *my* days as the  
sand.

**19 My root was spread out by the waters, and the dew lay all night upon my branch.**

**20 My glory was fresh in me, and my bow was renewed in my hand.**

**21 Unto me *men* gave ear, and waited, and kept silence at my counsel.**



**22 After my words they spake not again; and my speech dropped upon them.**

**23 And they waited for me as for the rain; and they opened their mouth wide *as* for the latter rain.**

24 *If* I laughed on them, they  
believed *it* not; and the light of my  
countenance they cast not down.  
25 I chose out their way, and sat  
chief, and dwelt as a king in the  
army, as one *that* comforteth the  
mourners.

1 I made a covenant with mine eyes;  
why then should I think upon a  
maid?

2 For what portion of Eloah *is there*  
from above? and *what* inheritance  
of the Almighty from on high?



**3 Is not destruction to the wicked?  
and a strange *punishment* to the  
workers of iniquity?**

**4 Doth not he see my ways, and  
count all my steps?**

**5 If I have walked with vanity, or if  
my foot hath hasted to deceit;**

**6 Let me be weighed in an even balance, that Eloah may know mine integrity.**

**7 If my step hath turned out of the way, and mine heart walked after mine eyes, and if any blot hath cleaved to mine hands;**

**8 *Then* let me sow, and let another eat; yea, let my offspring be rooted out.**

**9** If mine heart have been deceived  
by a woman, or *if* I have laid wait at  
my neighbour's door;

**10** *Then* let my wife grind unto  
another, and let others bow down  
upon her.

**11** For this *is* an heinous crime; yea,  
it *is* an iniquity *to be punished by*  
the judges.



12 For it *is* a fire *that* consumeth to destruction, and would root out all mine increase.

13 If I did despise the cause of my manservant or of my maidservant, when they contended with me;

14 What then shall I do when El riseth up? and when he visiteth, what shall I answer him?

**15 Did not he that made me in the  
womb make him? and did not one  
fashion us in the womb?**

**16 If I have withheld the poor from  
*their* desire, or have caused the  
eyes of the widow to fail;**

**17 Or have eaten my morsel myself  
alone, and the fatherless hath not  
eaten thereof;**

18 (For from my youth he was  
brought up with me, as *with* a father,  
and I have guided her from my  
mother's womb;)

19 If I have seen any perish for want  
of clothing, or any poor without  
covering;

20 If his loins have not blessed me,  
and *if* he were *not* warmed with the  
fleece of my sheep;



**21 If I have lifted up my hand  
against the fatherless, when I saw  
my help in the gate:**

**22 *Then* let mine arm fall from my  
shoulder blade, and mine arm be  
broken from the bone.**

**23 For destruction *from* El was a  
terror to me, and by reason of his  
highness I could not endure.**

**24 If I have made gold my hope, or  
have said to the fine gold, *Thou art*  
my confidence;**

**25 If I rejoiced because my wealth  
*was* great, and because mine hand  
had gotten much;**

**26 If I beheld the sun when it  
shined, or the moon walking *in*  
brightness;**

**27 And my heart hath been secretly  
enticed, or my mouth hath kissed  
my hand:**

**28 This also *were* an iniquity *to be  
punished by* the judge: for I should  
have denied the El *that is* above.**

**29 If I rejoiced at the destruction of  
him that hated me, or lifted up  
myself when evil found him:**



**30 Neither have I suffered my  
mouth to sin by wishing a curse to  
his soul.**

**31 If the men of my tabernacle said  
not, Oh that we had of his flesh! we  
cannot be satisfied.**

**32 The stranger did not lodge in the  
street: *but* I opened my doors to the  
traveller.**

**33 If I covered my transgressions as  
Adam, by hiding mine iniquity in my  
bosom:**

**34 Did I fear a great multitude, or  
did the contempt of families terrify  
me, that I kept silence, *and* went  
not out of the door?**

35 Oh that one would hear me!  
behold, my desire *is, that* the  
Almighty would answer me, and  
*that* mine adversary had written a  
book.

36 Surely I would take it upon my  
shoulder, *and* bind it *as* a crown to  
me.



**37 I would declare unto him the  
number of my steps; as a prince  
would I go near unto him.**

**38 If my land cry against me, or that  
the furrows likewise thereof  
complain;**

**39 If I have eaten the fruits thereof  
without money, or have caused the  
owners thereof to lose their life:**

**40 Let thistles grow instead of  
wheat, and cockle instead of barley.**

## Job 32-37

## Job 32

1 So these three men ceased to answer Job, because he was righteous in his own eyes.

2 Then was kindled the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled, because he justified himself rather than Elohim.

**3 Also against his three friends was his wrath kindled, because they had found no answer, and yet had condemned Job.**

**4 Now Elihu had waited till Job had spoken, because they were elder than he.**

5 When Elihu saw that *there* was no answer in the mouth of *these* three men, then his wrath was kindled.

6 And Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite answered and said, *I am young, and ye are very old; wherefore I was afraid, and durst not shew you mine opinion.*



**7 I said, Days should speak, and  
multitude of years should teach  
wisdom.**

**8 But *there is* a spirit in man: and  
the inspiration of the Almighty  
giveth them understanding.**

**9 Great men are not *always* wise:  
neither do the aged understand  
judgment.**

10 Therefore I said, Hearken to me;  
I also will shew mine opinion.

11 Behold, I waited for your words; I  
gave ear to your reasons, whilst ye  
searched out what to say.

12 Yea, I attended unto you, and,  
behold, *there was none of you that  
convinced Job, or that answered his  
words:*

**13 Lest ye should say, We have found out wisdom: El thrusteth him down, not man.**

**14 Now he hath not directed *his* words against me: neither will I answer him with your speeches.**

**15 They were amazed, they answered no more: they left off speaking.**



**16 When I had waited, (for they  
spake not, but stood still, *and*  
answered no more;)**

**17 *I said*, I will answer also my part,  
I also will shew mine opinion.**

**18 For I am full of matter, the spirit  
within me constraineth me.**

**19 Behold, my belly *is* as wine which  
hath no vent; it is ready to burst  
like new bottles.**

**20 I will speak, that I may be  
refreshed: I will open my lips and  
answer.**

**21 Let me not, I pray you, accept  
any man's person, neither let me  
give flattering titles unto man.**

**22 For I know not to give flattering  
titles; *in so doing* my maker would  
soon take me away.**

**1 Wherefore, Job, I pray thee, hear my speeches, and hearken to all my words.**

**2 Behold, now I have opened my mouth, my tongue hath spoken in my mouth.**

**3 My words *shall be* of the  
uprightness of my heart: and my lips

**4 The Spirit of El hath made me, and  
the breath of the Almighty hath given  
me life.**

**5 If thou canst answer me, set *thy*  
*words* in order before me, stand up.**

**6 Behold, I *am* according to thy wish  
in El's stead: I also am formed out of  
the clay.**

**7 Behold, my terror shall not make  
thee afraid, neither shall my hand  
be heavy upon thee.**

**8 Surely thou hast spoken in mine  
hearing, and I have heard the voice  
of *thy* words, saying,**



**9 I am clean without transgression, I  
*am* innocent; neither *is there*  
iniquity in me.**

**10 Behold, he findeth occasions  
against me, he counteth me for his  
enemy,**

**11 He putteth my feet in the stocks,  
he marketh all my paths.**

12 Behold, *in* this thou art not just: I  
will answer thee, that Eloah is  
greater than man.

13 Why dost thou strive against him?  
for he giveth not account of any of  
his matters.

14 For El speaketh once, yea twice,  
*yet man perceiveth it not.*

**15 In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men, in slumberings upon the bed;**

**16 Then he openeth the ears of men, and sealeth their instruction,**

**17 That he may withdraw man *from his* purpose, and hide pride from man.**



**18 He keepeth back his soul from  
the pit, and his life from perishing  
by the sword.**

**19 He is chastened also with pain  
upon his bed, and the multitude of  
his bones with strong *pain*:**

**20 So that his life abhorreth bread,  
and his soul dainty meat.**

**21 His flesh is consumed away, that it cannot be seen; and his bones *that* were not seen stick out.**

**22 Yea, his soul draweth near unto the grave, and his life to the destroyers.**

**23 If there be a messenger with him, an interpreter, one among a thousand, to shew unto man his uprightness:**

**24 Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom.**

**25 His flesh shall be fresher than a child's: he shall return to the days of his youth:**

**26 He shall pray unto Eloah, and he will be favourable unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness.**



27 He looketh upon men, and *if any* say, I have sinned, and perverted *that which was* right, and it profited me not;

28 He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the light.

29 Lo, all these *things* worketh El oftentimes with man,

**30 To bring back his soul from the  
pit, to be enlightened with the light  
of the living.**

**31 Mark well, O Job, hearken unto  
me: hold thy peace, and I will  
speak.**

**32 If thou hast any thing to say,  
answer me: speak, for I desire to  
justify thee.**

**33 If not, hearken unto me: hold thy  
peace, and I shall teach thee  
wisdom.**



## Job 34

1 Furthermore Elihu answered and said,

2 Hear my words, O ye wise *men*; and give ear unto me, ye that have knowledge.

3 For the ear trieth words, as the mouth tasteth meat.

**4 Let us choose to us judgment: let us know among ourselves what *is* good.**

**5 For Job hath said, I am righteous: and El hath taken away my judgment.**

**6 Should I lie against my right? my wound *is* incurable without transgression.**

- 7 What man *is* like Job, who  
drinketh up scorning like water?
- 8 Which goeth in company with the  
workers of iniquity, and walketh  
with wicked men.
- 9 For he hath said, It profiteth a  
man nothing that he should delight  
himself with Elohim.



10 Therefore hearken unto me, ye men of understanding: far be it from El, *that he should do wickedness; and from the Almighty, that he should commit iniquity.*

11 For the work of a man shall he render unto him, and cause every man to find according to *his* ways.

12 Yea, surely El will not do wickedly, neither will the Almighty pervert judgment.

**13 Who hath given him a charge  
over the earth? or who hath  
disposed the whole world?**

**14 If he set his heart upon man, *if*  
he gather unto himself his spirit and  
his breath;**

**15 All flesh shall perish together,  
and man shall turn again unto dust.**

**16 If now *thou hast* understanding,  
hear this: hearken to the voice of  
my words.**

**17 Shall even he that hateth right  
govern? and wilt thou condemn him  
that is most just?**

**18 *Is it fit* to say to a king, *Thou art*  
wicked? *and* to princes, *Ye are*  
unrighteous?**



**19 *How much less to him that***  
**accepteth not the persons of princes,**  
**nor regardeth the rich more than the**  
**poor? *for they all are the work of his***  
**hands.**

**20 In a moment shall they die, and**  
**the people shall be troubled at**  
**midnight, and pass away: and the**  
**mighty shall be taken away without**  
**hand.**

**21 For his eyes *are* upon the ways of man, and he seeth all his goings.**

**22 *There is* no darkness, nor shadow of death, where the workers of iniquity may hide themselves.**

**23 For he will not lay upon man more *than right*; that he should enter into judgment with El.**

**24 He shall break in pieces mighty men without number, and set others in their stead.**

**25 Therefore he knoweth their works, and he overturneth *them* in the night, so that they are destroyed.**

**26 He striketh them as wicked men in the open sight of others;**



**27 Because they turned back from him, and would not consider any of his ways:**

**28 So that they cause the cry of the poor to come unto him, and he heareth the cry of the afflicted.**

29 When he giveth quietness, who then can make trouble? and when he hideth *his* face, who then can behold him? whether *it be done* against a nation, or against a man only:

30 That the hypocrite reign not, lest the people be ensnared.

31 Surely it is meet to be said unto El, I have borne *chastisement*, I will not offend *any more*:

**32 *That which* I see not teach thou me: if I have done iniquity, I will do no more.**

**33 *Should it be* according to thy mind? he will recompense it, whether thou refuse, or whether thou choose; and not I: therefore speak what thou knowest.**

**34 Let men of understanding tell me, and let a wise man hearken unto me.**



**35 Job hath spoken without knowledge, and his words were without wisdom.**

**36 My desire *is that* Job may be tried unto the end because of *his* answers for wicked men.**

**37 For he addeth rebellion unto his sin, he clappeth *his hands* among us, and multiplieth his words against El.**
