

This fourth beatitude is really a turning point in the series. The first three have been about our need for Elohim, about our desperate position in life.


1. Blessed are the poor in spirit—

being "poor in spirit" means I know that before Yahweh, I do not have what it takes and realize I'm a poor beggar who needs Yahweh every day.




2. Blessed are those who mourn—

why would I mourn? Because I see that my sins are many. I must mourn over my sins, why? because they've been costly to me and to others, and most of all, they were unspeakably costly to Yahshua Messiah;



3. Blessed are the meek—

I grow in meekness because I see that Elohim has not treated me as my sins deserve. He has treated me with grace and kindness. As I continue getting used to the hand and staying in the yoke with Yahshua Messiah and allowing meekness to be developed in my life.



The first three beatitudes are about seeing your own position before Elohim. This fourth beatitude moves us forward. Hunger is more than a vague interest, it is an intense desire. A person who is really hungry will do almost anything to get food. His life depends on it.

Hunger is the strongest of motives.

It produces energy and it drives decisive action. It's powerful.

3 For we are the circumcision, which worship Yahweh in the spirit, and rejoice in Messiah Yahshua, and have no confidence in the flesh. 4 Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more:

- 5 Circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee;

15 Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, Elohim shall reveal even this unto you.



Three observations about hunger



1. Hunger is a sign of need When you are hungry, your body is telling you something: It's been too long since your last meal and you need to eat. Hunger indicates the absence of food in the body. It is the body's awareness of its own need. shall deliver them from the min the time of trouble. because they trust in h: the wind deliver.

Psalms 107:1-9

- 1 O give thanks unto Yahweh, for he is good: for his mercy endureth for ever.
 - 2 Let the redeemed of Yahweh say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;

4 They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in.

- 5 Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.

Yahshua tells us that the ones who are blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness. In other words, the blessed ones are not those who think they have righteousness, but those who feel they lack righteousness. the Lond shall help time of trouble. shall deliver them from them, and deliver they trust in h:

Here's what it feels like to be a Christian: You don't feel that you have arrived. You find yourself longing to be more like Messiah than you are. You say, "I wish I was further along." of the wicked shall be cut off.

Some people are confident of their own righteousness. The Pharisees were like that, but Yahshua does not pronounce them "blessed." The blessing does not belong to those who see themselves as paragons of virtue. The blessing is for those who see how far they have to go.



Other people are content in their sins. Yahshua does not pronounce them "blessed" either. The blessing belongs to those who are not content to remain as they are, but have a strong desire to grow in righteousness.

If that is you, Yahshua says you are "blessed."

2. Hunger is a sign of life

Nobody teaches a newborn baby how to be hungry. They don't need mentoring on this—where there's life, there's hunger. Spurgeon says:




To hunger after righteousness is a sign of spiritual life. Nobody who was spiritually dead ever did this... If you hunger and thirst after righteousness, you are spiritually alive... When the Spirit of Elohim has changed our nature, that new nature hungers and thirsts after righteousness. The old never would do so. nature never did, never could, and

The flesh never hungers after righteousness. It wants to go and sin. If you hunger for righteousness, thank Elohim for it.



3. Hunger is a sign of health

A healthy appetite is a good sign that a person is well. But if a person loses his appetite, it is usually a sign that something is wrong. Apply this spiritually:



If you have a deep longing to grow in Messiah, that's a good statement about your spiritual health. The sign of spiritual health is not to feel that you've arrived, but to have a great longing for more.


The mark of a true Christian is that he never feels he has arrived at a righteous life. What does he do? He hungers and thirsts for righteousness.

And this hunger is a sure sign of spiritual life and health. the wicked shall be cut off.

We want to be blessed, but Yahshua does not say that we are righteous, if we hunger and thirst to be blessed. He says we are blessed, if we hunger and thirst to be righteous. Do you see how easy it is, even for Christians, to get this the wrong way around?

2 Corinthians 5



1 For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of Elohim, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. 2 For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:

- 7 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)
- 8 We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with Yahweh.
- 9 Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him.

10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Messiah; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad. 11 Knowing therefore the terror of Yahweh, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto Elohim; and I trust also are made manifest in your consciences.

12 For we commend not ourselves again unto you, but give you occasion to glory on our behalf, that ye may have somewhat to answer them which glory in appearance, and not in heart.

13 For whether we be beside ourselves, it is to Elohim: or whether we be sober, it is for your cause.

14 For the love of Messiah constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:

15 And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again. 16 Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Messiah after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more.

17 Therefore if any man be in Messiah, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

18 And all things are of Yahweh, who hath reconciled us to himself by Yahshua Messiah, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that Yahweh was in Messiah, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

20 Now then we are ambassadors for Messiah, as though Yahweh did beseech you by us: we pray you in Messiah's stead, be ye reconciled to Elohim.

21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of Yahweh in him.

1 Peter 2:24-25

24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

25 For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

The purpose of the passion of Yahshua Messiah is that we should have a passion for righteousness. Messiah died to redeem a people who no longer live for themselves, but who live with a passion for holiness. tion of the righteous is o the Lord shall help them, and deliver they frust; om the

Five Strategies for Cultivating a Appetite for Yahweh



1. Gain momentum from the first three beatitudes

The Beatitudes are progressive. Each beatitude assumes the ones that have gone before. You can't just hunger and thirst for righteousness, you have to start from the beginning. We've pictured them like rings that are reached by the momentum you gain from swinging on the previous ones.

This doesn't mean you have to spend a week being poor in spirit and a month mourning over sins before you can move on. The momentum of realizing your poverty before Yahweh, seeing your own sins, and submitting yourself unconditionally to the will of Yahweh may happen all at once.


Yahweh may birth all of this in your heart with great power today. The point is simply that if progress is to be made, none of these elements, which we have pictured as rings, can be missing.

So, you can't start at the fourth beatitude and decide that you want to have a great hunger for holiness. But here's the encouragement: If you become poor in spirit, mourn your sins, and submit your life to the will of Elohim, you will find that a true hunger and thirst for righteousness springs from these roots.

2. Practice fasting from legitimate pleasures
"If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me." Mark 8:34



Let's apply that obvious principle from the world of the body to the world of the soul: Legitimate pleasures at the wrong time and in the wrong amount will spoil your appetite for holiness.
