## THY HOUDON COME

Matthew 6:10

#### Psalms 145

1 I will extol thee, my Elohim, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever. 2 Every day will I bless thee; and I will praise thy name for ever and ever.

3 Great is Yahweh, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness is unsearchable. **4 One generation shall praise** thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts.

5 I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works. 6 And men shall speak of the might of thy terrible acts: and I will declare thy greatness.

7 They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness. 8 Yahweh is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.

9 Yahweh is good to all: and his tender mercies are over all his works. 10 All thy works shall praise thee, O Yahweh; and thy saints shall bless thee. 11 They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;

12 To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom. 13 Thy kingdom *is* an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion *endureth* throughout all generations.

14 Yahweh upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all those that be bowed down. 15 The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season.

16 Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing. 17 Yahweh is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works. 18 Yahweh is nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.

**19 He will fulfil the desire of** them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them. 20 Yahweh preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.

21 My mouth shall speak the praise of Yahweh: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.

# THY Matthew 6:10 COME

# WHAT is the kingdom of Elohim?

The first thing to recognize is that after almost six weeks of teaching about the kingdom of Elohim by Yahshua (between his resurrection and his ascension to heaven), the Kingdom of Elohim was very real to the apostles and they fully expected it's arrival – Yahshua did not correct them in this but only commented on the timescale involved:

## THY Hatthew 6:10 COME

#### Acts 1:1-9

1 The former treatise have I made, **O** Theophilus, of all that Yahshua began both to do and teach, 2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Spirit had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

3 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of Yahweh:

4 And, being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me.

5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days hence. 6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Master, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel? 7 And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.

8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Spirit is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. 9 And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.
