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Matthew 6:10
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When questioned did Yahshua tell Pilate that he was to become a king, but not of this present age/world, implying that it will be in the age/world to come later?

John 18:28-38

28 Then led they Yahshua from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover.

29 Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?

30 They answered and said unto him, If he were not a malefactor, we would not have delivered him up unto thee.

31 Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death.

32 That the saying of Yahshua might be fulfilled, which he spake, signifying what death he should die.

33 Then Pilate entered into the judgment hall again, and called Yahshua, and said unto him, Art thou the King of the Jews?

34 Yahshua answered him, Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of me?

35 Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done?

36 Yahshua answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence.

**37 Pilate therefore said unto him,
Art thou a king then? Yahshua
answered, Thou sayest that I am a
king. To this end was I born, and
for this cause came I into the
world, that I should bear witness
unto the truth. Every one that is of
the truth heareth my voice.**

38 Pilate saith unto him, **What is truth? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all.**



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Did Yahshua also tell his disciples that he would rule in the new world or new age (referring to himself as the son of man)?

Matthew 19:23-28

23 Then said Yahshua unto his disciples, **Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven.**

24 And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the **kingdom of Yahweh.**

25 When his disciples heard it, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be saved?

26 But Yahshua beheld them, and said unto them, **With men this is impossible; but with Yahweh all things are possible.**

27 Then answered Peter and said unto him, Behold, we have forsaken all, and followed thee; what shall we have therefore?

**28 And Yahshua said unto them,
Verily I say unto you, That ye which
have followed me, in the
regeneration when the Son of man
shall sit in the throne of his glory,
ye also shall sit upon twelve
thrones, judging the twelve tribes
of Israel.**



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**Does Paul also speak about this
'world to come'?**

Hebrews 2:1-5

- 1 Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard lest at any time we should let them slip**
- 2 For if the word spoken by angels was steadfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a just recompence of reward;**

3 How shall we escape if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Master, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard him;

4 Elohim also bearing them witness both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to his own will?

**5 For unto the angels hath he not
put in subjection the world to come
whereof we speak**



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**Does Isaiah prophecy of this reign
of Yahweh through His Messiah
Yahshua?**

Isaiah 52:7

**How beautiful upon the mountains
are the feet of him that bringeth
good tidings, that publisheth
peace; that bringeth good tidings
of good, that publisheth salvation;
that saith unto Zion, Thy Elohim
reigneth!**



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Does the book of Revelation refer to the time when the kingdoms of this world become the kingdom of God and of His Christ (Messiah)?

Revelation 11:15

**And the seventh angel sounded;
and there were great voices in
heaven, saying, The kingdoms of
this world are become the
kingdoms of our Sovereign, and of
his Messiah; and he shall reign for
ever and ever.**

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**Does Yahshua say that he
has been given power from
the Father to rule over the
nations?**

Revelation 2:26-27

26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

27 And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.



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So we can now see that the kingdom of Yahweh is nothing less than the new world government of Elohim (Yahweh, our Father) ruling over all the nations and peoples of the earth under the kingship of Yahshua his Messiah.



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WHY is the kingdom of
Yahweh coming?

In the garden of Eden Adam and Eve effectively rejected Elohim's rule over them through unbelief and disobedience, instigated by Satan. They, and all mankind thereafter unwittingly came under the rule of Satan.

Is this confirmed in Ephesians, referring to Satan as ‘the prince of the power of the air’ (an unseen spirit being influencing all mankind without our knowing it)?

Ephesians 2:1-3

1 And you hath he quickened, who were dead in trespasses and sins;

2 Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience:

3 Among whom also we all had our conversation in times past in the lusts of our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind; and were by nature the children of wrath, even as others.

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**Does Paul in the book of
Romans say we are either
slaves of sin (**Satan**) or of
righteousness (**Yahweh &
Messiah**)?**

Romans 6:16-19

16 Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?

17 But Elohim be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you.

18 Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness.

19 I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness.



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**What does Yahshua say
about it?**

John 8:28-36

28 Then said Yahshua unto them,
When ye have lifted up the Son of
man, then shall ye know that I am he,
and that I do nothing of myself; but as
my Father hath taught me, I speak
these things.

29 And he that sent me is with me: the
Father hath not left me alone; for I do
always those things that please him.

30 As he spake these words, many believed on him.

31 Then said Yahshua to those Jews which believed on him, **If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;**

32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

33 They answered him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free?

34 Yahshua answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin.

35 And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever.

36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.
