THY COME

Matthew 6:10



Were the apostles told that Messiah (Yahweh's anointed agent through whom he carries out His plan) would return in the same way as he had gone (into the clouds on the Mount of Olives, out of the clouds arriving on the Mount of Olives)?

Acts 1:11-14

11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Yahshua, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.

12 Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.

- 13 And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas the brother of James.
- 14 These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Yahshua, and with his brethren.



Will he destroy those who oppose Yahweh?

2 Thessalonians 1:8

In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not Yahweh, and that obey not the good news of our Master Yahshua Messiah:



Will all the kingdoms of the world become the kingdom of our Elohim and of His Messiah when this trumpet is blown?

Revelation 11:15

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Sovereign, and of his Messiah; and he shall reign for ever and ever.



We have seen that Yahweh's kingdom will be ushered in, with Messiah as king, when he returns from heaven with all the power and glory given he by the Father.

He will overthrow the wicked and destroy those who fight against Yahweh's government with overwhelming power, setting people free from Satan's bondage and instituting the right conditions for the loving and righteous rule of Yahshua to deliver universal peace, prosperity and joy for all remaining mankind.



In the next study we will look at WHERE this will take place and WHO will be involved.

The Kingdom of Yahweh Pt.3

In Part 1 we looked at WHAT the kingdom of God is, and WHY it is coming, using two of Kipling's 'honest serving men'. In Part 2 we studied the scriptures regarding WHEN this will take place and HOW it will be brought about.

In this study we will continue and examine what the bible teaches about WHERE this will happen and WHO will be involved.



WHERE will the kingdom of Yahweh be?

Did Yahshua teach his disciples (and by extension us) to pray to the Father for His kingdom to come? Was it to come to earth and involve our Father's will being done here on earth 'as it is in heaven'?

Matthew 6:10

Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.



Will Messiah arrive on the Mount of Olives just outside Jerusalem, to set up Yahweh's government starting from here – on the earth?

Zechariah 14:1-4

- 1 Behold, the day of Yahweh cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee.
- 2 For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city.

3 Then shall Yahweh go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle.

4 And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.



Were the apostles told that Messiah would return in the same way as he had gone (into the clouds on the Mount of Olives, out of the clouds arriving on the Mount of Olives) – back to the earth?

Acts 1:10-12

10 And while they looked stedfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel;

11 Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Yahshua, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.

12 Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is from Jerusalem a sabbath day's journey.



Will Elohim's kingdom and government be established and flow out of Jerusalem – on the earth?

Isaiah 2:1-4

- 1 The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.
- 2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of Yahweh's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it.

3 And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of Yahweh, to the house of the Elohim of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem.

4 And he shall judge among the nations, and shall rebuke many people: and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruninghooks: nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more.



Did Yahshua say the inheritance of the meek was to be the earth?

Matthew 5:5

Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.



Was the promise to Abraham and his descendants to inherit the world?

Romans 4:13

For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.



Are the saints to rule the earth?

1 Corinthians 6:1-2

1 Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the unjust, and not before the saints? 2 Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters?



Is it the earth that will be full of the knowledge of Yahweh?

Isaiah 11:9

They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of Yahweh, as the waters cover the sea.

Habakkuk 2:14

For the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the glory of Yahweh, as the waters cover the sea.

Psalms 96:9-13

9 O worship Yahweh in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.

10 Say among the heathen that Yahweh reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously.

- 11 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof.
 - 12 Let the field be joyful, and all that is therein: then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice
- 13 Before Yahweh: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.



Does Messiah instruct us to be ready for his return to the earth?

Luke 21:33-38

33 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.

34 And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares.

35 For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth.

36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.

37 And in the day time he was teaching in the temple; and at night he went out, and abode in the mount that is called the mount of Olives.

38 And all the people came early in the morning to him in the temple, for to hear him.



So it is evident that Messiah returns to the earth and establishes the kingdom of Elohim here on earth.



Let us now see who is involved in the kingdom of Yahweh that is to be set up and ruled over by Messiah Yahshua. WHO should we expect to be involved in the kingdom of Yahweh?



First of all, as we have seen it is the kingdom belonging to Yahweh Elohim our Father, it is His rule and government that He administers through Yahshua as Messiah king here on earth.

Daniel 7:13-14

13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.

14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed.

Matthew 19:28

And Yahshua said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.

Luke 22:28-29

28 Ye are they which have continued with me in my temptations. 29 And I appoint unto you a kingdom, as my Father hath appointed unto me;

Mathew 25:31-34

31 When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: 32 And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats:

33 And he shall set the sheep on his right hand, but the goats on the left.

34 Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:

Revelation 11:15

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Sovereign, and of his Messiah; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

Luke 1:30-33

30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with Elohim. 31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name YAHSHUA.

32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and Yahweh Elohim shall give unto him the throne of his father David: 33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.



Will Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, together with all the prophets be in the kingdom?

Luke 13:28

There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of Yahweh, and you yourselves thrust out.



Can 'flesh and blood' inherit the kingdom of God?

John 3:3-6

- 4 Nicodemus saith unto him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born?
- 5 Yahshua answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of Yahweh.
- 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

1 Corinthians 15:47-50

47 The first man is of the earth, earthy; the second man is the Master from heaven. 48 As is the earthy, such are they also that are earthy: and as is the heavenly, such are they also that are heavenly.

49 And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly. 50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of Yahweh; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.



But will we who are Messiah's at his return be changed so we can inherit the kingdom with him?

1 Corinthians 15:51-58

- 51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. 54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

55 O death, where *is* thy sting? O grave, where *is* thy victory?
56 The sting of death *is* sin; and the strength of sin *is* the law.

57 But thanks be to Elohim, which giveth us the victory through our Master Yahshua Messiah. 58 Therefore, my beloved brethren, be ye stedfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of Yahweh, forasmuch as ye know that your labour is not in vain in Yahweh.



Will the saints of the Most High receive the kingdom?

Daniel 7:15-18

15 I Daniel was grieved in my spirit in the midst of my body, and the visions of my head troubled me. 16 I came near unto one of them that stood by, and asked him the truth of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things.

17 These great beasts, which are four, are four kings, which shall arise out of the earth. 18 But the saints of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever.

Daniel 7:27

And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.

Luke 12:32

Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom.

2 Peter 1:1-11

1 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Yahshua Messiah, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of Elohim and our Saviour Yahshua Messiah: 2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of Yahweh, and of Yahshua our Master,

3 According as his majestic power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and holiness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the majestic nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

5 And beside this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; 6 And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience holiness; 7 And to holiness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.

8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Master Yahshua Messiah. 9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall: 11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Master and Saviour Yahshua Messiah.



Will we rule over the earth with Messiah?

Revelation 2:18-29

18 And unto the angel of the assembly in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of Yahweh, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet are like fine brass; 19 I know thy works, and charity, and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and the last to be more than the first.

20 Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee, because thou sufferest that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit fornication, and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

- 21 And I gave her space to repent of her fornication; and she repented not.
- 22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds.

- 23 And I will kill her children with death; and all the assemblies shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.
- 24 But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.

25 But that which ye have already hold fast till I come. 26 And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

- And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father.
- 28 And I will give him the morning star.
- 29 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the assemblies.

Revelation 3:14-22

14 And unto the angel of the assembly of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of **Elohim**;

15 I know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: I would thou wert cold or hot.

16 So then because thou art lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. 17 Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

18 I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich, and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

- 19 As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.
- 20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

- 21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.
- 22 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the assemblies.



Who will not inherit a part in the kingdom?

Galatians 5:19-21

19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, 20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,

21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of Yahweh.

Ephesians 5:1-5

1 Be ye therefore followers of Elohim, as dear children; 2 And walk in love, as Messiah also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to Yahweh for a sweetsmelling savour.

3 But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; 4 Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

5 For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Messiah and of Yahweh.

1 Corinthians 6:9-10

9 Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of Yahweh? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, 10 Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of Yahweh.



The goods news is that we don't have to remain like that! Look at verse 11 if you wish to be an inheritor of the kingdom of Elohim:

1 Corinthians 6:11

And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Master Yahshua, and by the Spirit of our Elohim.

2 Thessalonians 1:3-5

3 We are bound to thank Elohim always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth; 4 So that we ourselves glory in you in the assemblies of Yahweh for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure:

5 Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of Elohim, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of Elohim, for which ye also suffer:



Will Satan and his influence be taken out of the picture?

Revelation 20:1-3

- 1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.
- 2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.



So we see that the kingdom belongs to the Father but He is delighted to place His dearly beloved son Yahshua on the throne to rule over the earth as king.



It is also His good pleasure to grant us His children a part in the kingdom as our inheritance, ruling with and under Messiah the king.



As many scriptures detail, this is a wonderful righteous and just government for the benefit of all the earth's inhabitants, ushering in universal peace, abundance and joy - living the way our Elohim planned it from the very beginning.
