


## # 11 Torah Parashah -Vayigash (וִיִּגִּשׁׁ)— Hebrew for "and he drew near"

Gen 44:18 And Yehudah came near to him and said, "O my master, please let your servant speak a word in my master's hearing, and do not let your displeasure burn against your servant, for you are like Pharaoh.

Gen 44:19 "My master asked his servants, saying, 'Nave you a father or a brother?'

#### **Abraham Intercedes**

#### Judah Intercedes

Exo 24:2 "But Mosheh shall draw near to יהוה by himself, and let them not draw near, nor let the people go up with him."

Gen 44:20 "And we said to my master, 'We have a father, an old man, and a young child of his old age, and his brother is dead, and he alone is left of his mother's children, and his father loves him.' Gen 44:23 "But you said to your servants, 'Unless your youngest brother comes down with you, you do not see my face again.'

Gen 44:24 "And it came to be, when we went up to your servant my father, that we told him the words of my master.

Gen 44:25 "And our father said, 'Go back and buy us a little food.'

Gen 44:26 "But we said, 'We are not able to go down. If our youngest brother is with us, then we shall go down, for we are not able to see the man's face unless our youngest brother is with us.' Gen 44:27 "Then your servant my father said to us, 'You know that my wife bore me two sons, Gen 44:28 and the one went out from me, and I said, "Truly, he is torn, torn to pieces!" And I have not seen him since.

Gen 44:29 And if you take this one from me too, and harm comes to him, you shall bring down my grey hair with evil to She'ol.'

Gen 44:30 "And now, if I come to your servant my father and the boy is not with us - since his own life is bound up in his life -

Gen 44:31 then it shall be, when he sees that the boy is not with us, that he shall die. So your servants shall bring down the grey hair of your servant our father with evil to She'ol.

Gen 44:32 "For your servant went guaranty for the boy to my father, saying, 'If I do not bring him back to you, then I shall be a sinner before my father forever.'

Gen 44:33 "And now, please let your servant remain instead of the boy as a slave to my master, and let the boy go up with his brothers.

Gen 44:34 "For how do I go up to my father if the boy is not with me, lest I see the evil that would come upon my father?"

### Chapter 45) Yosef's reveals himself

Gen 45:4 Then Yoséph said to his brothers, "Please come near to me." And when they came near, he said, "I am Yoséph your brother, whom you sold into Mitsrayim.

#### Gen. 45-The 4 Deeds by which we are Redeemed

- 1) We do not change our hebrew name(45:4 "I am Yosef")
- 2) We do not let go of our hebrew language (45:12)
  - 3) We do not speak negative against another (No Lashon HaRa)-Evil tongue
  - 4) We do not let go of the Covenants Elohim has made with us...
