




# The two White Horses in Revelation Yahshua returns to judge Edom/Islam

The first white horse of the first Seal in Rev. 6:2 represents a false religious system allowed to conquer... This horse is not to be confuse with the white horse who represents Messiah the Conquering King in Rev.19:11-21 whose vesture is covered in blood from treading the false system that is persecuting His people.



Rev 19:11 And I saw the heaven opened, and there was a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Trustworthy and True, and in righteousness He judges and fights.

Rev 19:12 And His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns, having a Name that had been written, which no one had perceived except Himself –

Rev 19:13 and having been dressed in a robe dipped in blood – and His Name is called: The Word of איהוה.

Rev 19:14 And the armies in the heaven, dressed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses.

Rev 19:15 And out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should smite the nations. And He shall shepherd them with a rod of iron. Psa 2:9 And He treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Ěl Shaddai.

Rev 19:16 And on His robe and on His thighd He has a name written: SOVEREIGN OF SOVEREIGNS AND MASTER OF MASTERS.

Rev 19:17 And I saw one messenger standing in the sun, and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in mid-heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great Elohim,

Rev 19:18 to eat the flesh of sovereigns, and the flesh of commanders, and the flesh of strong ones, and the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great."

Rev 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the sovereigns of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to fight Him who sat on the horse and His army. Rev 19:20 And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he led astray those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshipped his image. The two were thrown alive into the lake of fire burning with sulphur.

Rev 19:21 And the rest were killed with the sword which came from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse, and all the birds were filled with their flesh.

In Revelation 19:15 we read that Yahshua "will treading the winepress of the fury of the wrath of Elohim the Almighty" where Elohim's enemies are portrayed as being crushed like grapes. But it is in Isaiah 63 that we have the original context for this passage, and it is specifically in Edom that Messiah is seen to be crushing His enemies, actually soaking his garments with their blood.

Isa 63:1 Who is this coming from Edom, with garments of glowing colours from Botsrah, who is robed in splendour, striding forward in the greatness of His strength? "It is I who speak in righteousness, mighty to save."

Isa 63:2 Why is there red on Your raiment, and Your garments like one who treads in the winepress?

Isa 63:3 "I have trodden the winepress alone, and from the peoples no one was with Me. And I trod them down in My displeasure, and I trampled them in My wrath. Their blood is sprinkled upon My garments, and I have defiled all My raiment.

Isa 63:4 "For a day of vengeance is in My heart, and the year of My redeemed has come.

Isa 63:5 "And I looked, but there was none helping, and I was astonished that there was none upholding. So My own arm saved for Me, and My wrath upheld Me.

Isa 63:6 "And I trod down peoples in My displeasure, and made them drunk in My wrath, and brought down their strength to earth."

וצם 63:7 Let me recount the loving-commitments of and the praises of יהוה, according to all that יהוה has done for us, and the great goodness toward the house of Yisra'ĕl, which He has done for them according to His compassion, and according to His many loving-commitments.

Isa 63:8 And He said, "They are My people, children who do not act falsely." And He became their Saviour.

Isa 63:9 In all their distress He was distressed, and the Messenger of His Presence saved them. In His love and in His compassion He redeemed them, and He lifted them up and carried them all the days of old.

Isa 63:10 But they rebelled and grieved His Setapart Spirit, so He turned against them as an enemy, and He fought against them.

Isa 63:11 Then He remembered the days of old, Mosheh, His people, "Where is He who brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of His flock? Where is He who put His Set-apart Spirit within him,

Isa 63:12 who led them by the right hand of Mosheh, with His comely arm, dividing the water before them to make for Himself an everlasting Name,

Isa 63:13 who led them through the deep? Like a horse in the wilderness they did not stumble."

Isa 63:14 As a beast goes down into the valley, and the Spirit of יהוה causes him to rest, so You led Your people, to make Yourself a comely Name.

Isa 63:15 Look down from the heavens, and see from Your set-apart and comely dwelling. Where are Your ardour and Your might, the stirring of Your inward parts and Your compassion toward me? Are they withheld?

Isa 63:16 For You are our Father, though Abraham does not know us, and Yisra'ěl does not recognise us. You, O יהוה, are our Father, our Redeemer – Your Name is from of old.

Isa 63:17 O יהוה, why do You make us stray from Your ways, and harden our heart from Your fear? Turn back, for the sake of Your servants, the tribes of Your inheritance.

Isa 63:18 For a little while Your set-apart people possessed it – our adversaries have trodden down Your set-apart place.

Isa 63:19 We have become like those over whom You never ruled – Your Name is not called on them!

#### Judgment on the Nations

Isa 34:1 Come near, you nations, to hear. And listen, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all its offspring.

Isa 34:2 For the displeasure of יהוה is against all the nations, and His wrath against all their divisions. He shall put them under the ban, He shall give them over to the slaughter,

Isa 34:3 and their slain be thrown out, and their stench rise from their corpses. And mountains shall be melted with their blood.

Isa 34:4 And all the host of the heavens shall rot away. And the heavens shall be rolled up like a scroll, and all their host fade like a leaf fading on the vine, and like the fading one of a fig tree.

Isa 34:5 "For My sword shall be drenched in the heavens. Look, it comes down on Edom, and on the people of My curse, for judgment.

Isa 34:6 "The sword of יהוה shall be filled with blood, it shall be made overflowing with fatness, and with the blood of lambs and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams. For יהוה has a slaughtering in Botsrah, and a great slaughter in the land of Edom.



Yahshua returns at the end of the tribulation to defend Israel against the unjust assault of her enemies and to specifically execute judgment against Edom(i.e. Islam)





The Apostasy- The Falling Away from the Truth(Elohim's Torah(commandments) and Faith in Yahshua





1Ti 4:1 But the Spirit distinctly says that in latter times some shall fall away from the belief, paying attention to misleading spirits, and teachings of demons,

1Ti 4:2 speaking lies in hypocrisy, having been branded on their own conscience,

2Th 2:1 As to the coming of our Master יהושע Messiah and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, brothers,

2Th 2:2 not to become easily unsettled in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as if the day of יהוה has come.

2Th 2:3 Let no one deceive you in any way, because the falling away is to come first, and the man of lawlessness is to be revealed, the son of destruction,





We see a falling away from Elohim's commandments in Christianity along with the emergence of the man of sin(Anti-christ) in Islam!

Rev 14:12 Here is the endurance of the setapart ones, here are those guarding the commands of Elohim and the belief of יהושע. ואר 2:22 Who is the liar, except the one denying that יהושע is the Messiah? This is the anti-messiah, the one denying the Father and the Son.

1Jn 4:1 Beloved ones, do not believe every spirit, but prove the spirits, whether they are of Elohim, because many false prophets have gone out into the world. 1Jn 4:2 By this you know the Spirit of Elohim: Every spirit that confesses that יהושע Messiah has come in the flesh is of Elohim,

יהושע 1Jn 4:3 and every spirit that does not confess that יהושע Messiah has come in the flesh is not of Elohim. And this is the spirit of the anti-messiah which you heard is coming, and now is already in the world.

1Jn 4:4 You are of Elohim, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

2Jn 1:6 And this is the love, that we walk according to His commands.a This is the command, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it. 2Jn 1:7 Because many who are leading astray went out into the world who do not confess יהושע Messiah as coming in the flesh. This one is he who is leading astray and the anti-messiah.

2Jn 1:8 See to yourselves, that we do not lose what we worked for, but that we might receive a complete reward. 2Jn 1:9 Everyone who is transgressing and not staying in the teaching of Messiah does not possess Elohim. The one who stays in the teaching of Messiah possesses both the Father and the Son.



What is the spirit of Antichrist and where is it seen today? 1Jn 2:18 Little children, it is the last hour. And as you have heard that the anti-messiah is coming, even now many anti-messiahs have come. This is how we know that it is the last hour.

1Jn 2:19 They went out from us, but they were not of us, for if they had been of us, they would have stayed with us – but in order that it might be made manifest that none of them were of us.


1Jn 2:20 And you have an anointing from the Setapert One, and you know all.

1Jn 2:21 I did not write to you because you do not know the truth, but because you know it, and because no falsehood is of the truth.

ואר 2:22 Who is the liar, except the one denying that is the Messiah? This is the anti-messiah, the one denying the Father and the Son.

1Jn 2:23 No one denying the Son has the Father. The one confessing the Son has the Father as well.

On the spot in Jerusalem where Yah once descended to his people in ancient Temple and where it is prophesied that He will rebuild the temple and rule the nations as High Priest and King... a mosque of defiance was set up... with words from Qur'an encircling the inside of the dome of the rock saying, "Far be it from His Glory that God should have a son!" 



Around the octagonal structure is a long classical Arabic inscription that says that God has no begotten son, thus denying that Yahshua Messiah is the son of God:
