The Season Of Teshuvah: **Turning from sin and preparing for** the Messiah's return!



ELUL is a time to prepare for JUDGMENT.

Due to the seriousness of our need to repent, and so that we will not forget to turn to ELOHIM with all our heart, the shofar is repeatedly blown for the entire thirty-day period of the month of ELUL.



THS IS A TIME THAT WE PREPARE OURSELVES AND MAKE SURE WE ARE READY TO HEAR THE SOUND OF THE SHOFAR



Lev 23:23 And ההיה spoke to Mosheh, saying,

Lev 23:24 "Speak to the children of Yisra'ěl, saying, 'In the seventh new moon, on the first day of the new moon, you have a rest, a remembrance of Teru'ah a set-apart gathering.

Lev 23:25 'You do no servile work, and you shall יהוה bring an offering made by fire to הוה." "





The season of Teshuvah or Repentance is a time of forsaking our sin and turning to YAH for forgiveness and for healing, it's a time that the bride is making herself ready for the bridegroom. And it's a time to be VERY SERICUS



This is a solemn season to inspect our own hearts a season of humility.



It's a time to look into our hearts and ask the Ruach HaKodesh to search our hearts and reveal any hidden sins, and to repent and make Teshuvah and work at walking according to the Spirit and not the Flesh.



GALATIANS 5:16-21

Gal 5:16 And I say: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not accomplish the lust of the flesh.

Gal 5:17 For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh. And these are opposed to each other, so that you do not do what you desire to do.




Gal 5:18 But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under Torah.

Gal 5:19 And the works of the flesh are wellknown, which are *these*: adulterya, whoring, uncleanness, indecency,



<u>Gal 5:21</u> envy, murders, drunkenness, wild parties, and the like – of which I forewarn you, even as I also said before, that those who practise such as these shall not inherit the reign of Elohim.

Gal 5:20 idolatry, drug sorcery, hatred, quarrels, jealousies, fits of rage, selfish ambitions, dissensions, factions,



<u>1Jn 2:6</u> The one who says he stays in Him ought himself also to walk, even as He walked.



TO WALK IN THE SPIRIT IS TO WALK IN THE TRUTH OF YAH'S WORD! (TORAH)



SIN IS DECEPTIVE (1 John 1:8-10; Hebrews 3:13; Romans 7:11-25)


<u>1Jn 1:8</u> If we say that we have no sin, we are misleading ourselves, and the truth is not in us.

1Jn 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is trustworthy and righteous to forgive us the sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

<u>1Jn 1:10</u> If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His Word is not in us.



Heb 3:13 but encourage one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened by the **DECEIVABLENESS** of sin.



Rom 7:11 For sin, having taken the occasion through the command, <u>DECEIVED</u> me, and through it killed me.

Rom 7:12 So that the Torah truly is set-apart, and the command set-apart, and righteous, and good.



Rom 7:13 Therefore, has that which is good become death to me? Let it not be! But the sin, that sin might be manifest, was working death in me through what is good, so that sin through the command might become an exceedingly great sinner.

Rom 7:14 For we know that the Torah is Spiritual, but I am fleshly, sold under sin.





Rom 7:15 For what I work, I know not. For what I wish, that I do not practise, but what I hate, that I do.

Rom 7:16 But if I do what I do not wish, I agree with the Torah that it is good.

Rom 7:17 And now, it is no longer I that work it, but the sin dwelling in me.





<u>Rom 7:18</u> For I know that in me, that is in my flesh, dwells no good. For to wish is present with me, but to work the good I do not find.

<u>Rom 7:19</u> For the good that I wish to do, I do not do; but the evil I do not wish to do, this I practise.



Rom 7:20 And if I do that which I do not wish, it is no longer I who work it, but the sin dwelling in me.

<u>Rom 7:21</u> I find therefore this law, that when I wish to do the good, that the evil is present with me.




Rom 7:22 For I delight in the Torah of Elohima according to the inward man, Footnote: aSee Psa 119:16

<u>Rom 7:23</u> but I see another torah in my members, battling against the torah of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the torah of sin which is in my members.



Rom 7:24 Wretched man that am! Who shall deliver me from this body of death?

<u>Rom 7:25</u> Thanks to Elohim, through יהושע Messiah our Master! So then, with the mind I myself truly serve the Torah of Elohim, but with the flesh the torah of sin.




Luk 18:10 "Two men went up to the Set-apart Place to pray – the one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector.

Luk 18:11 "The Pharisee stood and began to pray with himself this way, 'Elohim, I thank You that I am not like the rest of men, swindlers, unrighteous, adulterers, or even as this tax collector.


Luk 18:12 I fast twice a week, I give tithes of all that I acquire.'

Pro 16:17 The highway of the straight is to turn away from evil; He who guards his life watches over His way. **Pro 16:18** Before destruction *comes* pride, And before a fall a haughty spirit!



<u>1Pe 5:5</u> In the same way, you younger ones, be subject to elders. And gird yourselves with humility toward one another, for "Elohim resists the proud, but gives favour to the humble." <u>Pro 3:34</u>.


<u>1Pe 5:6</u> Humble yourselves, then, under the mighty hand of Elohim, so that He exalts you in due time,



LUKE 13:1-5

Luk 13:1 And some were present at that time, reporting to Him about the Galileans whose blood Pilate had mixed with their offerings.

<u>Luk 13:2</u> And יהושע answering, said to them, "Do you think that these Galileans were worse sinners than all other Galileans, because they have suffered like this?



Luk 13:3 "I say to you, no! But unless you repent

you shall all perish in the same way.

Luk 13:4 "Or those eighteen on whom the tower in Shiloah fell and killed them, do you think that they were greater offenders than all other men who dwelt in Yerushalayim?

Luk 13:5 "I say to you, no! But unless you repent you shall all perish in the same way."



2 SANUEL 12:1-14

<u>2Sa 12:1</u> Then יהוה sent Nathan to Dawid. And he came to him, and said to him, "There were two men in one city, one rich and the other poor.

2Sa 12:2 "The rich one had flocks and herds, very many.





<u>2Sa 12:3</u> "But the poor one had only one little ewe lamb which he had bought and kept alive. And it grew up with him and with his children together. It ate of his own food and drank from his own cup and lay in his bosom. And it was like a daughter to him.

2Sa 12:4 "And a traveller came to the rich man, who refused to take from his own flock and from his own herd to prepare one for the wayfaring man who had come to him, but he took the poor man's lamb and prepared it for the man who had come to him."




<u>2Sa 12:5</u> And the wrath of Dawid burned greatly יהוה against the man, and he said to Nathan, "As מיהוה lives, the man who has done this is a son of death!

<u>2Sa 12:6</u> "Also, he has to repay fourfold for the lamb, because he did this deed and because he had no compassion."



<u>2Sa 12:7</u> Then Nathan said to Dawid, "You are the man! Thus said רהוה Elohim of Yisra'ěl, 'I anointed you sovereign over Yisra'ěl, and I delivered you from the hand of Sha'ul.

<u>2Sa 12:8</u> And I gave you your master's house and your master's wives into your bosom, and gave you the house of Yisra'ěl and Yehudah. And if that were not enough, I also would have given you much more!



<u>2Sa 12:10</u> And now, the sword does not turn aside from your house, because you have despised Me, and have taken the wife of Uriyah the Hittite to be your wife.'

יהוה <u>2Sa 12:9</u> Why have you despised the Word of איהוה to do evil in His eyes? You have struck Uriyah the Hittite with the sword, and his wife you took to be your wife, and you have killed him with the sword of the children of Ammon.



<u>2Sa 12:11</u> "Thus said יהוה, 'See, I am raising up evil against you, from your own house, and shall take your wives before your eyes and give them to your neighbour, and he shall lie with your wives in the sight of this sun.

<u>2Sa 12:12</u> For you did it in secret, but I shall do this deed before all Yisra'ěl, and before the sun.'"



2Sa 12:13 And Dawid said to Nathan, "I have sinned against יהוה." And Nathan said to Dawid, "Also, יהוה has put away your sin, you shall not die.

2Sa 12:14 "However, because by this deed you have greatly scorned יהוה, the child also who is born to you shall certainly die."



Teshuvah is one of the most greatest gift of Grace that YAH has ever given to us its the ability to turn back to him and seek healing of our brokenness.



PSALMS 51:1-17

Psa 51:1 Show me favour, O Elohim, According to Your loving-commitment; According to the greatness of Your compassion, Blot out my transgressions.

Psa 51:2 Wash me completely from my guilt, And cleanse me from my sin.



Psa 51:3 For I know my transgressions, And my sin is ever before me.

Psa 51:4 Against You, You alone, have I sinned, And done evil in Your eyes; That You might be proven right in Your words; Be clear when You judge.





Psa 51:5 See, I was brought forth in crookedness, And in sin my mother conceived me.

Psa 51:6 See, You have desired truth in the inward parts, And in the hidden part You make me know wisdom.



Psa 51:7 Cleanse me with hyssop, and I am clean; Wash me, and I am whiter than snow.

Psa 51:9 Hide Your face from my sins, And blot out all my crookednesses.


Psa 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O Elohim, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.





Psa 51:11 Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Set-apart Spirit from me.


Psa 51:12 Restore to me the joy of Your deliverance, And uphold me, Noble Spirit!

Psa 51:16 For You do not desire slaughtering, or I would give it; You do not delight in ascending offering. Psa 51:17 The slaughterings of Elohim are a broken spirit, A heart broken and crushed, O Elohim, These You do not despise.

<u>Psa 51:15</u> O יהוה, open my lips, And that my mouth declare Your praise.



JAMES 4:6-10

Jas 4:6 But He gives greater favour. Because of this He says, "Elohim resists the proud, but gives favour to the humble." Pro 3:34.

Jas 4:7 So then subject yourselves to Elohim. Resist the devilb and he shall flee from you.






Jas 4:8 Draw near to Elohim and He shall draw near to you. Cleanse hands, sinners. And cleanse the hearts, you double-minded!

<u>Psa 103:8</u> יהוה is compassionate and showing favour, Patient, and great in loving-commitment.


-is doing righteousness And right יהוה is doing righteousness And right ruling for all the oppressed.

Psa 103:12 As far as east is from west, So far has He removed our transgressions from us.




Psa 103:13 As a father has compassion for his children, So יהוה has compassion for those who fear Him_
